## 21 new officers in \$48.6 million police budget

A \$48.6 million police services budget carrying a 3.8 per cent tax wallop was endorsed by Halton's administration and finance committee Wednesday.

If approved at council Wednesday, the budget will plump up property taxes by \$10 for the average homeowner.

But that's mitigated by a \$5 decline in the Regional portion of the tax bill, so the average resident will see an increase of \$4.88 on their property tax bill.

If endorsed, the Halton Regional Police budget will bring 21 new constables to the force.

"Our budget focuses on front-line strength," said police board chair Jack Brewer.

Overall, the recommended budget will cost the owner of a \$185,000 home \$279 per year.

And that's a reasonable deal, said Mr. Brewer.

"The average cost per household is less than a cup of coffee a day," he said.

Part of the cost increase is a result of provincially mandated adequacy standards.

The standards are policing guidelines imposed by, but not funded through, the Province. They're often devised from lessons learned from high-profile cases, such as convicted murderer Paul Bernardo and rape victim Jane Doe.

Milton Mayor Gord Krantz supported the budget but objected to Halton taxpayers having to pay for provincially-mandated adequacy standards.

"Has anyone thought of standing up to the Province and saying, 'No, I won't dance to your tune," asked Mr. Krantz.

But the trouble lies not with the standards, but with the lack of cash to ease them in, said Police Chief Ean Algar.

"It's difficult to say the adequacy standards aren't good," he said. "They're great for policing. But the reality is they're asking you to shoulder the costs at the same time."

In its presentation to the committee, police representatives aimed to prove that Halton has a fiscally-responsible force with lower than average per capita costs.

mittees this week is approved at council Wednesday.

That translates into a \$5 decrease for the owner of a home assessed at \$185,000.

But factor in a 3.8 per cent increase in the police services budget — amounting to just over \$10 per home — and the tax load will increase by .4 per cent, or \$4.88 per household.

Overall, owners of a \$185,000 home can expect to pay \$1,093 in regional and police taxes for 2000.

But there are still uncertainties in the budget. Final pooling costs, though estimated to be in the \$40-million range, haven't yet been unveiled by the Province.

And that means Regional staff have had to estimate the impacts in order to get the budget out, said Halton's finance commissioner Joe Rinaldo.

"We can't keep our books open forever," he said. "We held off as long as we can."

But staff estimates are likely close, assured Mr. Rossini.

"We don't anticipate the numbers to be swinging wildly this year," he said.

Still, any uncertainty puts the Region at risk, said Oakville Mayor Ann Mulvale.

That has been the case since the Province began downloading, she added.

"The biggest fight we had wasn't the Province's right to realign," said Ms Mulvale. "It's the exposure."

This year, Halton residents will pay just under \$250 for pooling on their property tax bill.

"It represents a significant slice," said Mr. Rossini. "It's about one fifth of our total."

And that number could increase as Halton's assessment base grows while Toronto's remains stagnant.

Asked if that was fair by Halton Hills Mayor Marilyn Serjeantson, Mr. Rinaldo replied "If you ask Toronto, they think we should be paying more. If you ask us, we already pay too much."
