




A good health tip from Milton District Hospital

Glen Eden to get \$1 million ski lift

By the start of next year's ski season, visitors to Glen Eden Ski Area will be whisked up the hill on a new quad-seat chairlift.

Conservation Halton recently approved the purchase of a \$1 million chairlift that will replace the 27-year-old Twister. The Twister, which seats three people, is the oldest chairlift at the ski

"It will increase the uphill capacity by 30 per cent," said Bob Burchett, director of conservation land services.

The new chairlift, which is manufactured by Poma Canada, will be installed by November 5, he said.

The proposal to purchase a new chairlift was first presented to Conservation Halton's community relations advisory committee March 9. At that time, Mr. Burchett explained to members that it was time to replace the Twister.

"We could keep it going but people would notice it would be stopped a lot," he said. And it would be expensive to make repairs.

The Twister is considered an orphan, an industry term meaning the company that originally manufactured the lift is no longer in business. And because of that, parts that have worn out or have broke would have to be custom-made — an expensive and timeconsuming process.

In addition, the chairlift would have to undergo an engineering review that would cost between \$30,000 and \$50,000 "with no guarantee of passing," Mr. Burchett said.

Glen Eden's other two lifts, the Sidewinder and Boomerang, are also made by Poma. The \$1 million comes out of the Glen Eden capital reserves.






