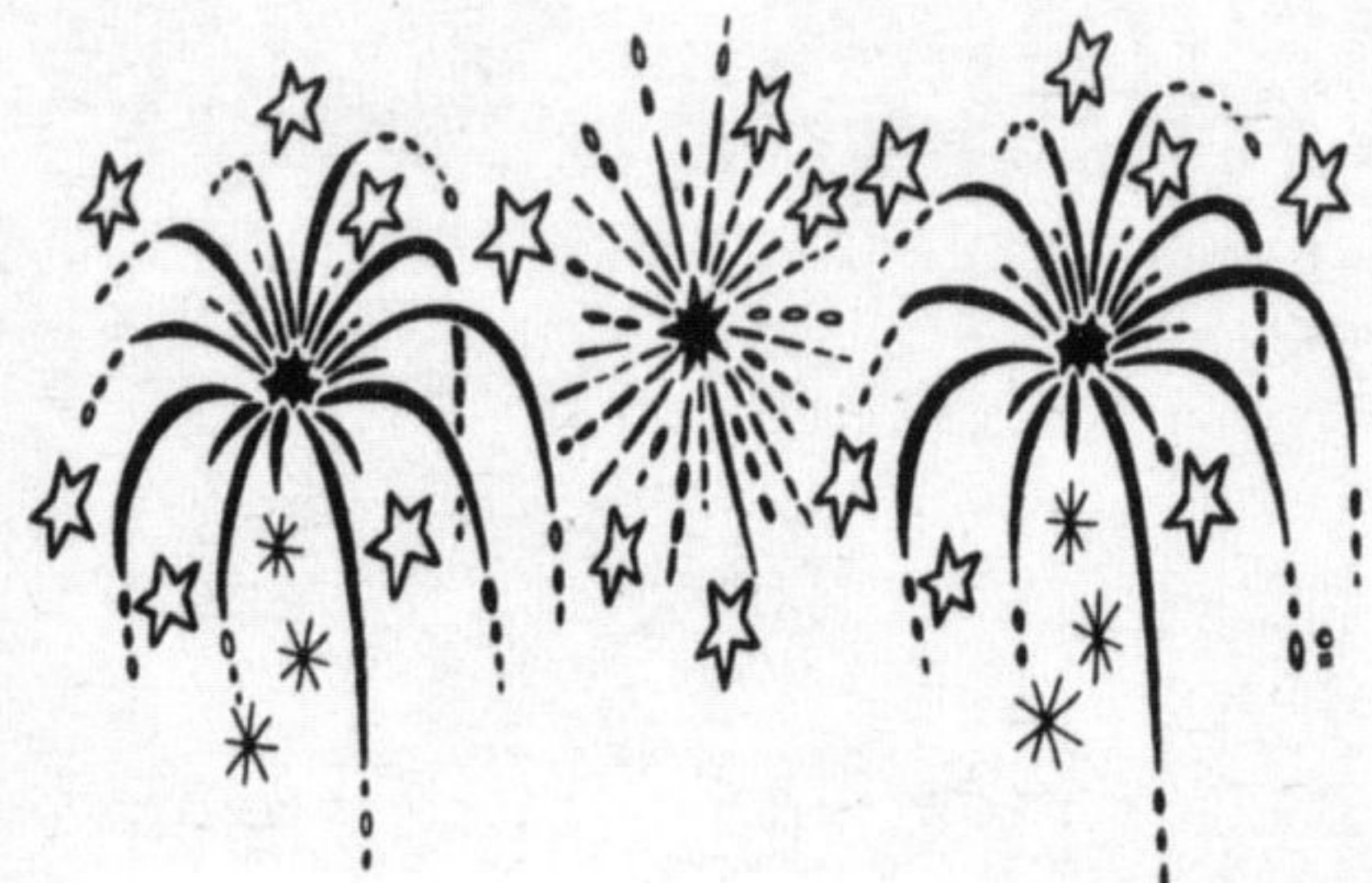

No drugs found in latest series of school searches

Bishop Reding Secondary School targeted by police

No drugs were found by police officers in searches last week at two Halton high schools, one in Milton.

Members of the Halton Regional Police Drug and Morality Bureau and Canada Customs Dog Detector Service conducted locker searches May 8 at Bishop Reding Secondary School on Main Street as well as T.A. Blakelock High School in Oakville.

"It's a message to the students that drugs won't be tolerated on school property," said Det. Scott Mason.

"It's a message the school administration sends to the students."

A handler walked through the halls of the schools with a drug detector dog.

If the dog detects drugs in a student's locker, it will be opened and a search conducted.

If a drug is discovered, an investigation will be launched and appropriate action will be taken.

So far, 10 schools — including the Ernest C. Drury School for the Deaf — have been searched during this school year.

No drugs were found in the Milton school, or any others in town over the past several years.

Project Hallwalk began in 1997 as a way to detect drugs in area high schools.
