

# Downtown market opens for season tomorrow

The Milton Farmers' Market will kick off another season of freshness tomorrow morning.

The giant Main Street sale of fresh produce will run weekly on Saturday mornings until October 28.

The market has been invigorating the down-

town core for 28 years, said a spokesman for the Milton Chamber of Commerce, which organizes the event.

"We probably have 30 vendors," said Jill Shaw, Chamber market manager.

"There are some new and returning vendors as well."

This year, there will be slight changes in the

make-up of the goods.

"This year we have more organic growers," said Ms Shaw.

"We also have a person who's going to do kind of face painting."

As usual, the market will boast a cornucopia of fresh fruits, vegetables, flowers, meats, fish, eggs, sweets and other baked goods, preserves

and cheese.

Some vendors will travel from as far as the Niagara region to sell their wares, according to Ms Shaw.

To accommodate the event, a portion of Main Street from Martin to James streets will be shut down every Saturday during market hours from 7 a.m. to noon.

As parents, I encourage you to be all that you can be! Your children

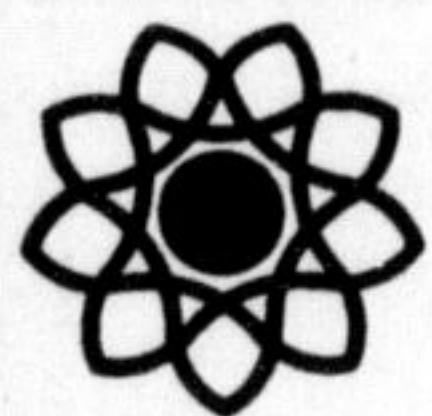

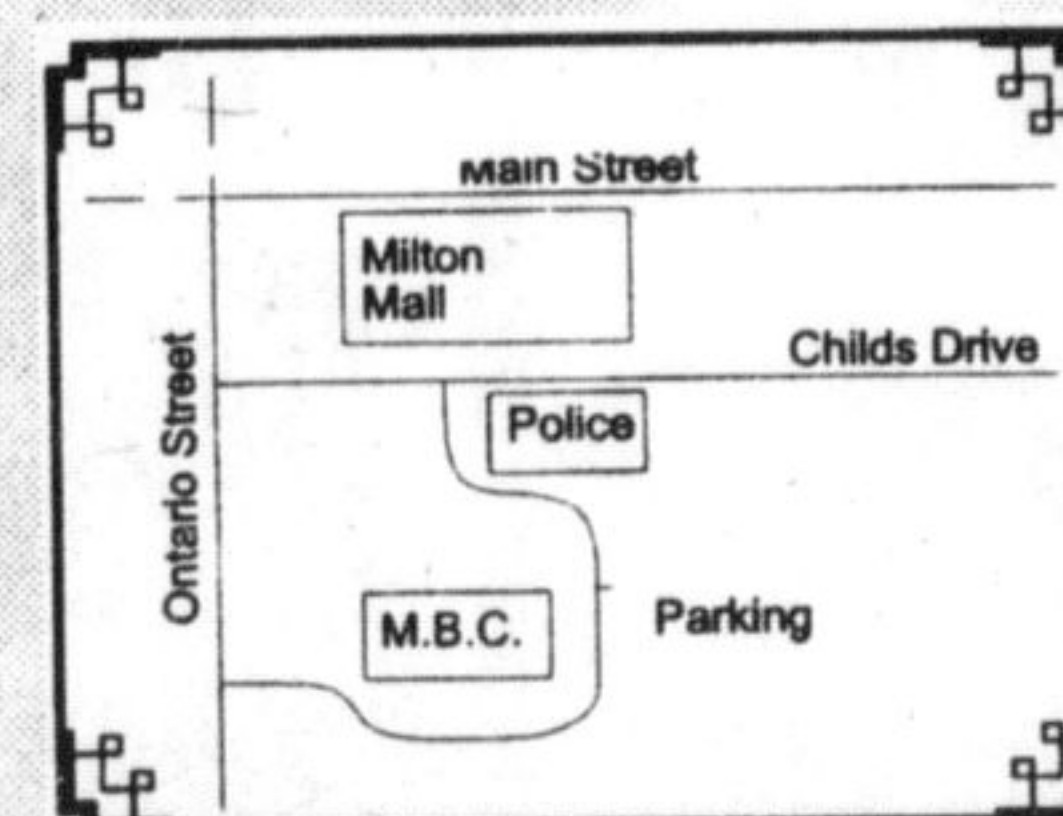
