Times have changed and not for the better. Our kids see more, they experience more, they grow up so much faster.

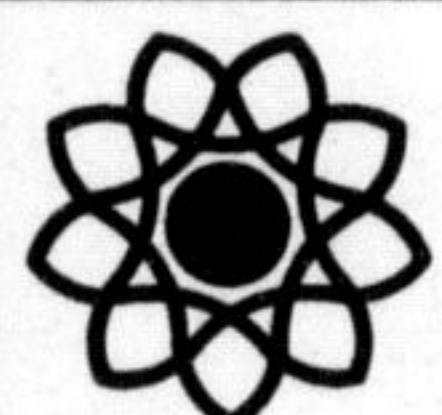
Founder and President of Focus on the Family, Dr. James Dobson states: "We must make the salvation of our children our number one priority. Nothing else is more important."

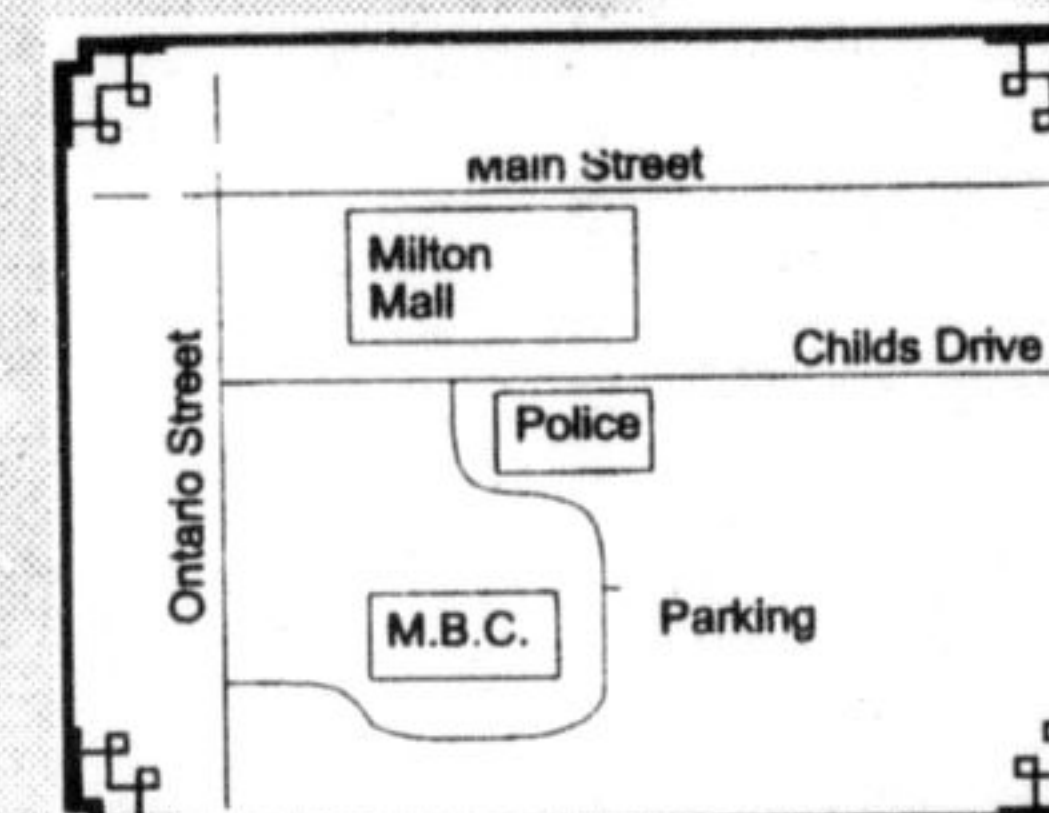
