MDH Ranked Top Eye Donor Centre

Milton District Hospital (MDH) was ranked the top eye donor centre per hospital bed in the provinve according to the 1999 Annual Report of the Eye Bank of Canada, Ontario Division. MDH retrieved 156 eyes in 1999, placing the hospital fourth in Ontario for overall volume. It is a ranking that the hospital has maintained for the last three years.

Cindy McDonell, Program Leader of Family Practice at MDH, believes the Eye Donation Program is so successful because of the sensitivity and commitment with which the staff generate program awareness at the hospital. "With every death at the hospital, we let the family members know thet their loved one's eyes are eligible for donation to the Eye Bank," explains McDonell. "We do not ask for the eyes. We simply present the family with the

McDonell notes that since MDH adopted this program four years ago, about sixty per cent choose to donate.

option. It is a family decision after that."

"The entire team is very dedicated, "McDonell says. "From the staff who approach the families to the physicians who retrieve the eyes. It's a real team effort. There's real commitmeent there."

Donated eyes are used for corneal transplants and other ocular surgeries as well as medical research and surgical training. "At the heart of every donor program are the donor families themselves," says McDonell. "At a time of sorrow, these families look beyond their grief to carry out the wishes of their loved ones in the hopes of restoring someone's sight."
