

Stolen car driver flees with gas

The person who filled a car up with gas Saturday and then left without paying was driving a stolen vehicle, Halton Regional Police say.

At about 9:30 a.m., a person filled a green four-door Jeep Cherokee with \$34.01 worth of gas from the Esso station on Regional Road 25.

When police checked the licence plate, they found the vehicle was stolen from the Kingston area.

Police pursuit

There was a police chase in town Sunday.

The pursuit began when a blue Chevrolet Camero failed to stop for a spot check at Ontario and Main streets at 3:45 a.m. The pursuit was called off at Derry Road and Guelph Line.

Police have the vehicle's licence plate and the investigation is continuing.

Cement mixer stolen

A portable cement mixer was stolen sometime between 5:30 p.m.

Attempted theft

the Italian Canadian Club sometime between 6 p.m. Sunday and 11:30 p.m. Monday.

The thieves made off with 20 O'Henry chocolate bars. The Tremaine Road club had been broken into twice earlier this year, with thieves netting alcohol.

Window broken

A window was damaged at Milton District High School shortly after 11 p.m. last Friday.

The school's caretaker heard people on the roof and was calling police when he heard the window break. The damage was estimated at \$300.

A group of 14 youths was stopped by police.

Fire started

The fire department was called to a fire at Pitfield Road and Ontario Street last Friday shortly after midnight.

Someone had set furniture and garbage on fire.

No damage estimate was available.

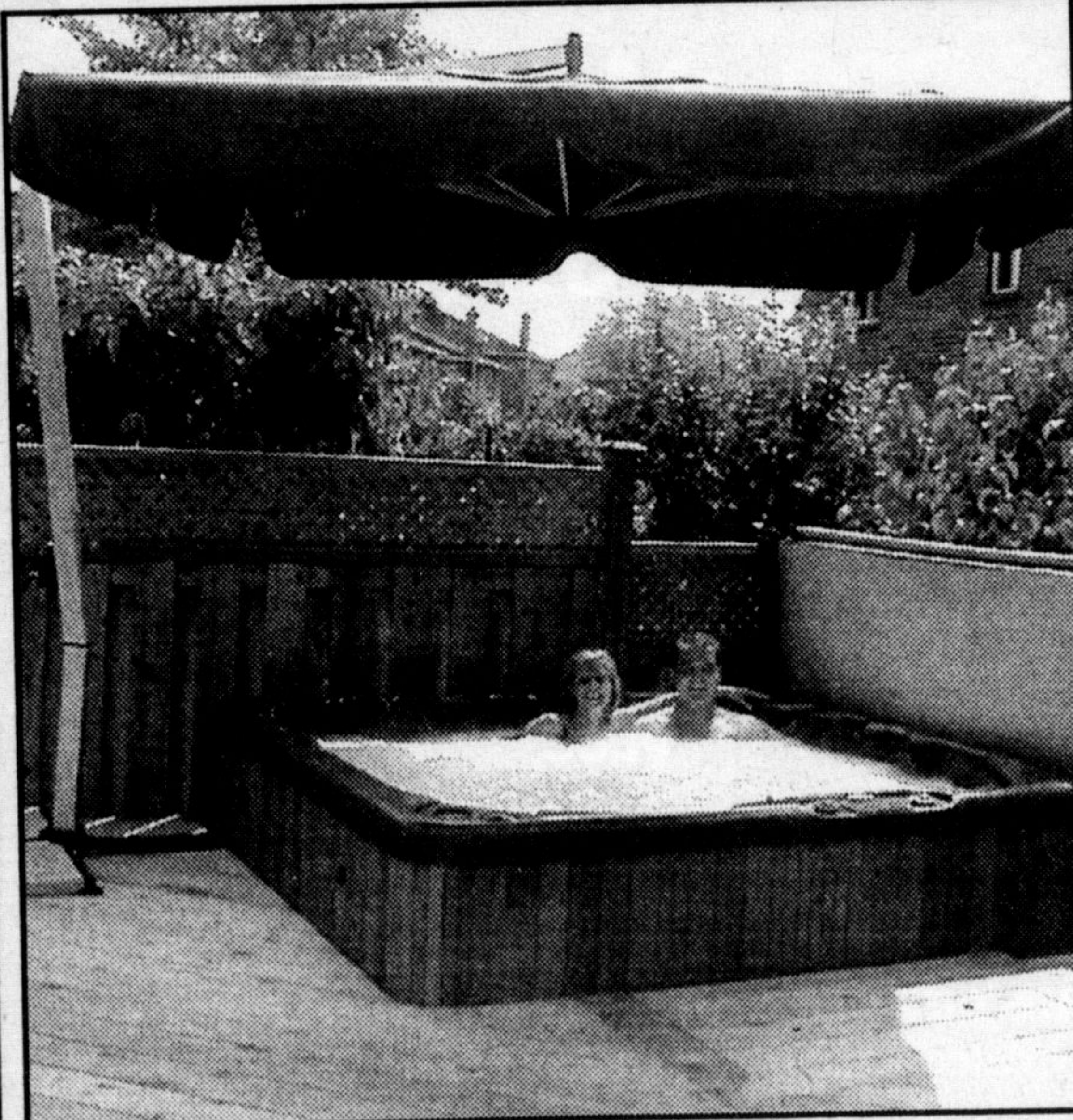

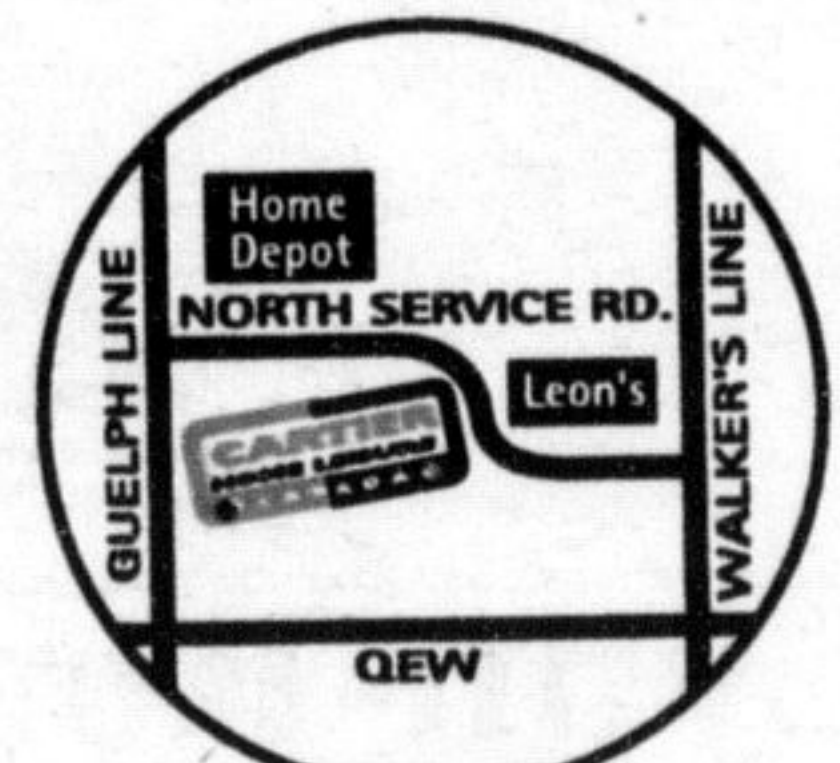

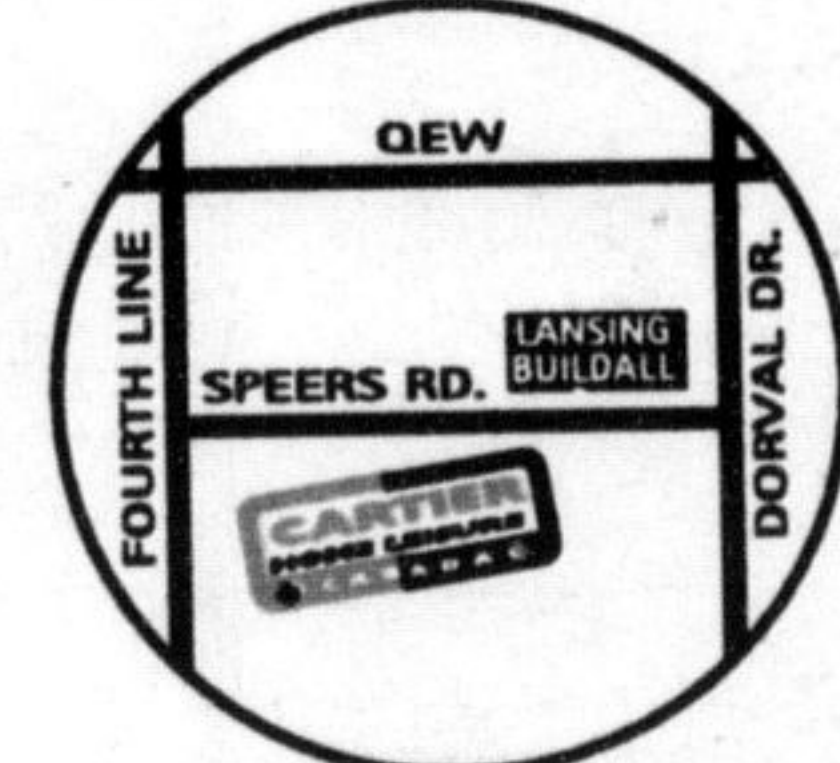
