

## Planning key to a successful perennial garden: experts

xperts and gardeners agree — the key to a beautiful perennial garden is in the planning.

"Try planning it," said Gay Bryant, a member secretary and director for the Milton Horticultural Society. "It would have been better if I did."

Ms Bryant and her husband Jim began planting their garden 13 years ago at their Fourth Line home.

She said she did it on a shoe-string budget, taking plants from other people's gardens and placing them wherever she felt was best.

The following year she had to dig up most of the plants because she had put them in the wrong spot or they had grown bigger than expected, she said.

Today, the couple's gardens are beautiful with flowers and trees bursting with colour and texture.

But the work is never finished. A garden is never complete, said Mary-Deane Crawford, owner of Crawford's Country Gardens in Milton. It's an ongoing project.

The first thing that people have to do is to decide the theme of the garden.

In a mono-chromatic garden, gardeners pick one colour and plant flowers that bloom in light and dark shades of it.

With an analogous garden, people pick three colours that sit side-by-side on the colour wheel. Examples of an analogous garden are flowers that are violet, blue and see THOUSANDS on page 5

2. Keep a covered container of water in the fridge for drinking water (so you don't have to run the tap waiting for the water to chill).

3. Put a little food colouring in your toilet tank and see if, without flushing, the colour begins to appear in the bowl - if so, you have

1. Avoid leaving the tap running unneces- a leak which should be fixed.

4. Put a brick or a small plastic container filled with water in the tank of your toilet; your toilet will require less water to flush each time.

5. Install water-conserving shower and faucet heads which are available at most hardware stores.
