IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990, c.O. 18 AND IN THE MATTER OF the lands and premises at the following municipal address in the Province of Ontario.

#### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE THAT THE Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton intends to designate the exterior only of the building at the following municipal address as a building of historical and architectural significance under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O. 18.

Municipal Address: 58 Victoria Street, Milton, Ontario  
REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION:

This gracious residence constructed in the late 1800's is built in true Victorian style, with steep pitches and gables, gingerbread trim and elongated, mullioned windows. The interior retains its original hardwood floors and carved woodwork, along with 12" deep mouldings. An original wooden staircase completes the period interior setting.

ANY PERSON MAY, within thirty (30) days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Milton, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.

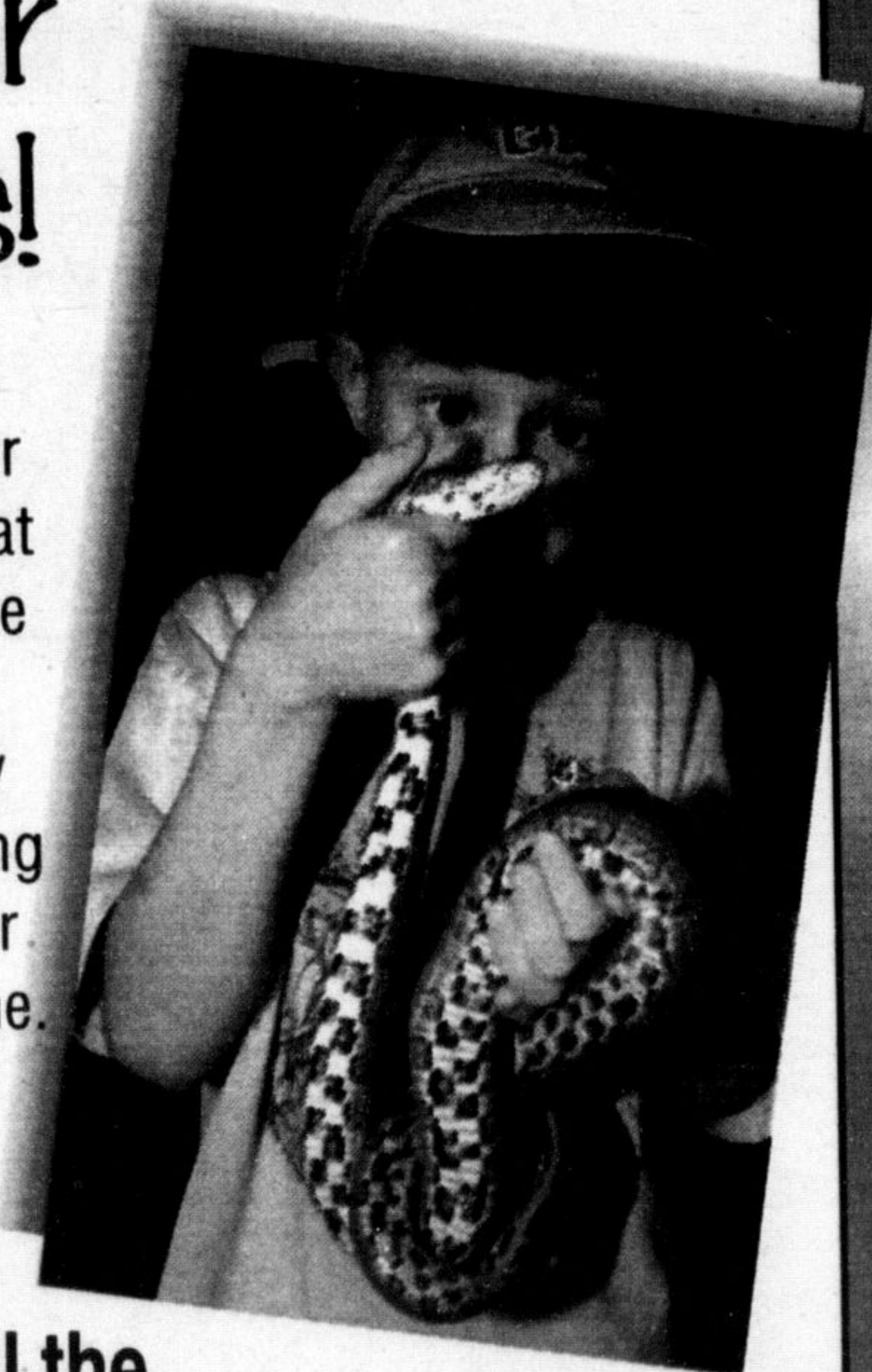
