Springer retires from gymnastics

Ashley Quinn garnered one more piece of hardware before bidding farewell to competitive gymnastics.

The 12-year-old, now officially retired from the sport (in order to pursue other challenges) after qualifying for the Central Region provincial team the last three years, was recently named 1999/2000 Athlete of the Year by the Milton Springers.

A truly deserving recipient of the award, she's captured a dozen gold medals over the past three years — including one on vault at the provincial championships in 1998.

Other top gymnasts honoured

The Milton Springers' Most Dedicated Gymnast award went to Jaimi Fellows. The 11-year-old undertook a rigorous training schedule this past year and exhibited unparalleled determination to improve several of her skills. These efforts helped her earn an independent berth to the provincial junior championships — which she marked with an eighth-place finish on beam.

Top Competitor awards, given to the gymnast with the top all-around score on the team, went to Jade Ryan at the interclub level and Quinn at the provincial team level.

Top Apparatus awards went gymnasts who won gold on an event in competition. They included Natasha Nunes and Christina Chimonides for vault, Anne Wormald for beam, Christine Nellis and Quinn for floor and Alexis Stoffels for overall scoring.

Taking the Most Improved all-around award was 11-year-old Stephanie Deumer, who upped her standings at each provincial qualifier — which culminated with a berth on the Central Region Novice 1 provincial team.

Most Improved Apparatus awards were given to Valerie Massel and Stefanie Proulx for vault, Amanda Steddy, Stevie Koot and Chimonides for bars, Fellows for beam and Eleanor Pineau-Levman for floor.

The Happy Face award for learning the most new skills went to 12-year-old Kristina Deumer. Most Focused competitor was awarded to Christina Shipowick, with Most confident gymnast going to Stoffels. Julie Gagnon — who at nine was the youngest member of the team — was named Most Sportsmanlike.

On The Beam trophies were presented to Stoffels, Shipowick and Stephanie Deumer while the First Kip on bars award was given to Koot. Voted by her peers as Teammate of the Year was 10-year-old Nunes.

The Springers' youngest team members were awarded for individual accomplishments over the past season. They included April Suslje for 'Always Willing To Try', Maddy Bannock for 'Most Determined To Succeed', Jessica Makin for 'Most Impressive Flexibility', Rebecca Woolford for 'Never Give Up' and Colleen Brown for 'Most Impressive Presentation'.

**Ontario Funding Affordable
Housing In The Regional
Municipality of Halton**

ATTENTION LANDLORDS AND BUILDERS

The provincial government is providing the Regional Municipality of Halton with funding to provide affordable rental housing for 84 individuals & families with low incomes as part of Ontario's new \$50 million rent supplement initiative.

Under the rent supplement program, the government contracts with landlords to offer rent-gated -to-income accommodation in privately owned buildings. The units are assigned to low-income tenants whose rents are subsidized by the government.
