Former CHF chair invited to voice concerns at meeting

Conservation Halton has invited a former chair of the organization's fundraising body to present her concerns at an upcoming meeting.

Former Conservation Halton Foundation (CHF) chair Janet Mitchell can "come to the next board of directors meeting as a delegate and present any concerns she has brought up in previous correspondences," said Bob Burchett,

director of conservation land services.

The invitation came after a two-hour in-camera session August 3 in which Conservation Halton (CH) members discussed letters written by Ms Mitchell.

The letters were the latest in the ongoing public controversy surrounding the dismissal of the volunteer board members of the CHF March 31: Ms Mitchell penned two letters — an open let-

Floyd McClung Jr., in his inspiring book, The original name of Karel Appel's work was My Many people long to know God personally, but I believe that God has created us to be like Father Heart of God, introduces his theme with a poignant illustration:
