## Cornfest held at Country Heritage Park: weekend

Ladies and gentleman, start your engines — Cornfest will be held this weekend at Milton's Country Heritage Park.

For two days, visitors to the park will find dozens of sweet, southern-Ontario corn succulently steam-cooked courtesy of a genuine Sawyer-Massey steam engine.

The sweet cobs dripping with butter, salt and pepper to taste cost \$1 a cob and will be served from about noon to 3 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday.

Last year, about 80 dozen cobs were sold at the event.

An ear-piercing blast from the engine will signal when a new batch of corn is put on the steamer, said Reg Cressman, general manager of the Tremaine Road facility.

"We put it in a massive cast iron pot and use the old steam engine to steam the corn," he said. "It takes about 45 minutes."

Fortunately, there's plenty of things to do while waiting.

Country Heritage Park — formerly the Ontario Agricultural Museum and Farm Museum — is a cornucopia of old-fashioned delights aimed at engaging the imaginations of kids of all ages.

The 80-acre site houses 31 buildings, including an 1860s Victorian homestead and John Deere building.

Antique tractors, threshing machines and steam engines are also on display.

Live guides will be on hand this weekend to paint a vivid picture of the history of the exhibits, and a wagon driver will act as a down home taxi service between the buildings.

Instructors will teach the mechanics of corn husk doll crafting. Rope-making through binder twine will also be on the agenda.

"We'll show how to make them and hopefully we'll have enough material for people to make their own," said Mr. Cressman.

The idea behind the park is to create a living snapshot of an earlier time.

That theme continues in the gift shop, which offers educational, entertaining toys — many for less than \$10.

Admission to the park costs \$7 for adults, \$6 for seniors and \$4 for children. Family passes cost \$20.

Park visitors are invited to bring a picnic or dine at the park restaurant. Or just indulge in golden-yellow, meltingly hot corn. Park hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

"It's a great day and it doesn't cost a lot," said Mr. Cressman. "And the added feature is the corn."
