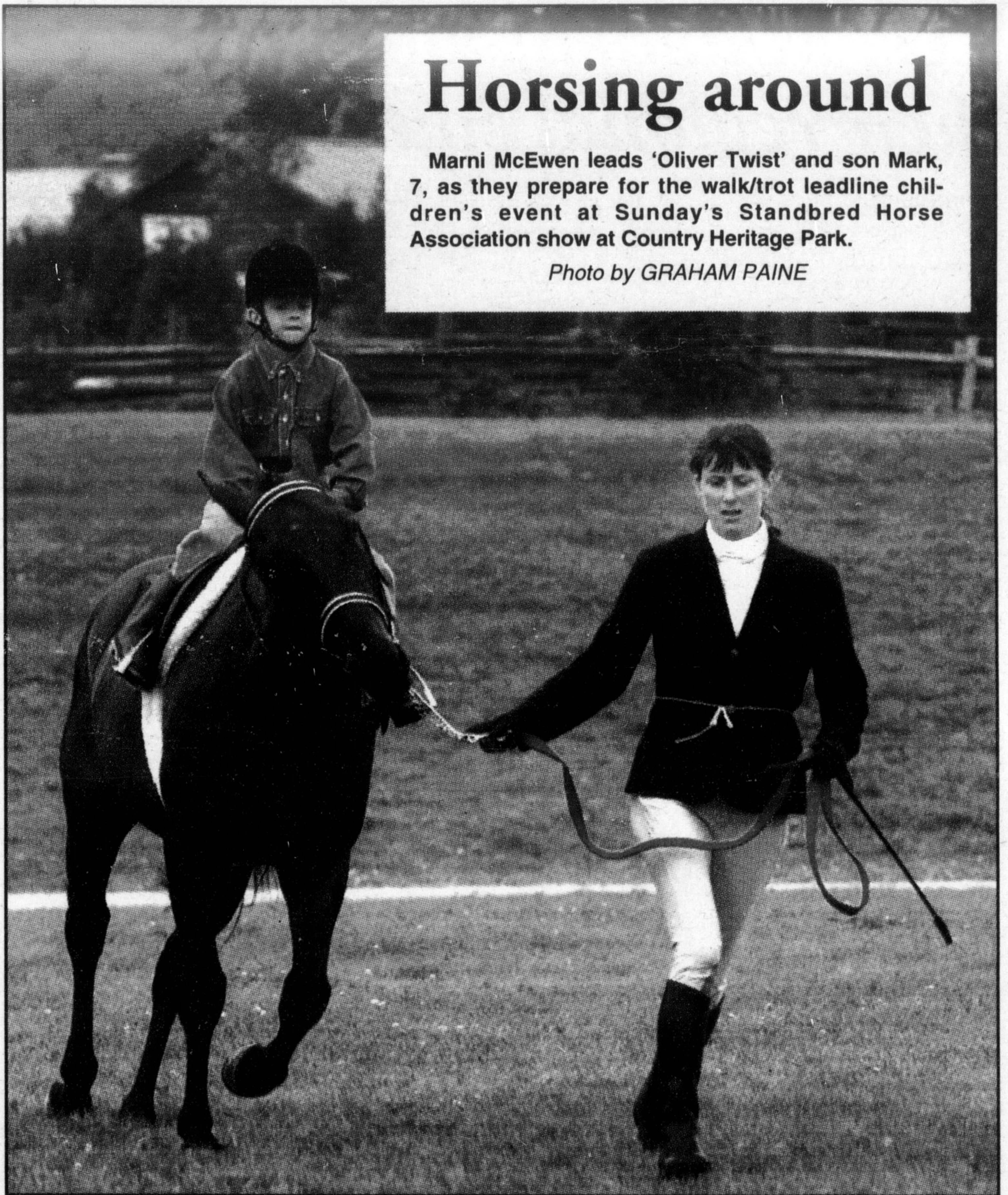

RECONSTRUCTION OF TWISS ROAD AND STEELES AVE. INTERSECTION

The Town of Milton is proceeding with the reconstruction of the Twiss Rd./Steeles Ave. intersection. The project involves intersection improvements and the lowering of the knoll on Steeles Ave. to the east of the intersection.
