INITIAL NOTICE FOR THOMPSON ROAD AND MAIN STREET IMPROVEMENTS

PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED

As a requirement under Ontario's Environmental Assessment Act, the Town of Milton hereby notifies all interested individuals and parties of plans to make improvements to Thompson Road between Derry Road and Steeles Avenue and Main Street between Thompson Road and James Snow Parkway (refer to map). This project is being conducted as a Schedule C activity according to the requirements outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association **Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Road Projects (Class EA)** document.

The purpose of this study is to address traffic, pedestrian and safety needs. The Town of Milton is considering upgrading and widening the roadways as well as providing additional sidewalks. Currently a traffic and road design review is being undertaken and various alternatives will be reviewed to address the identified needs.

Once alternative designs have been reviewed and a recommended solution developed, a Public Information Centre will be held to allow the public to review and comment on the proposed preliminary design. Further notification will be provided in advance of the Public Information Centre.

You are encouraged to contact the Town or its consultant, UMA Engineering Ltd., if you have any comments or questions about this project. If you feel, after consulting with town staff, that serious environmental concerns remain unresolved, requests for a "bump-up" may be made to the Minister of the Environment.
