Traffic and safety concerns dominate floor at hearing into land development

it's said, not how many times it's said," he said.
"Something said once well is enough."

As a result, the forum ended at about 10:30 p.m. — uncharacteristically early for the emotionally charged debate, which has dragged on until 1 a.m. in past public meetings.

Traffic and safety concerns dominated the floor. About 28 people spoke, with the vast majority opposing the development.

The meeting began with an overview of the current proposal, which has shifted often in the past

two years to accommodate the concerns of residents.

Mr. Watty described the issue as a large puzzle he was working to piece together in order to come up with an answer.

Earlier this week, developers H.D. Investments and Leisureworld Inc. continued their battle for the approval of their proposal at the OMB hearing held at Town Hall.

Opposing them is the Town, as well as the citizen's group Friends of E.C. Drury Park, the parent council of the Ernest. C. Drury School for the

Deaf and the Ontario Deaf Sports Association.

The Milton Tennis Club has been a participant at the hearing.

Experts on both sides were called on to give an opinion on everything from the safety of the proposed roads and access points, to the likelihood that drivers will use the development or schools as a short cut to reach where they're going faster.

Though it was hoped the hearing would last two weeks, a third week, scheduled for October 16, will almost certainly be required.
