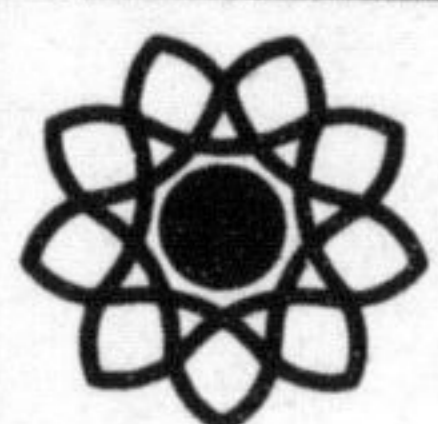
Within the greater community of Christian faith, dedicated ministers strive to create environments wherein people can see faith in

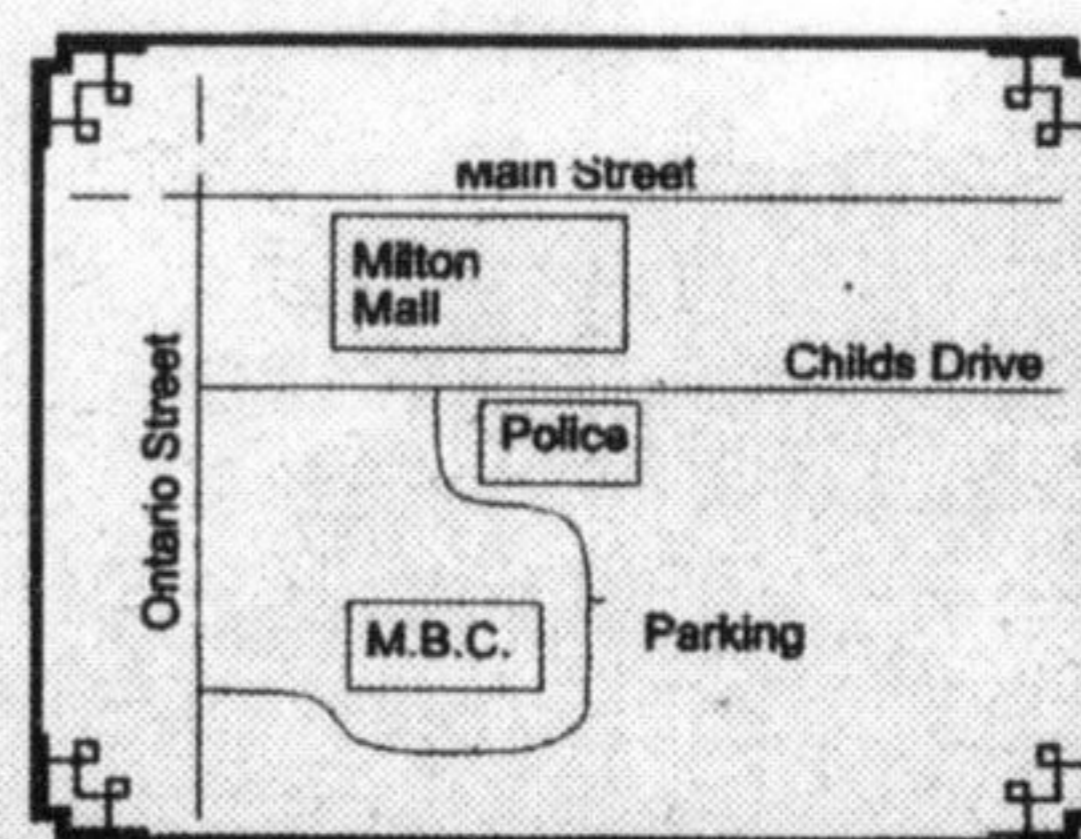
