

"The business that Wilton set to Yuk it up this weekend at Party Central

Milton can now call itself Party Central.

Celebrating its grand opening this Saturday, Party Central is a 14,000-square-foot entertainment facility that hosts live entertainment throughout the year.

"We think Halton Region is entertainment starved," said Joe Pinto, entertainment and events coordinator for Party Central.

"I have lived in Georgetown for over 20 years and I have to leave the town every time I want to do something."

But that has now changed.

Party Central is the exclusive location for Yuk Yuk's for Halton North. People can enjoy the same show as they would see downtown, but without the hassles of driving, said Mr. Pinto, who has been dealing with the comedy club for 12 years.

Presently, Yuk Yuk's will come to Milton once a month, but more shows may be added if there is a demand for it.

And like the show downtown, people also get a buffet dinner with the ticket.

The buffet — prepared by Party Central's own chefs - will change monthly. Tomorrow evening, people

can enjoy roast veal loin with demi-glaze, sweet basil chicken, penne pomadori, seasoned red roasted potatoes, mixed vegetables and all the trimmings.

Tickets are \$27, which is about \$9 cheaper than the shows in the city.

In addition to Yuk Yuks, Party Central will also host a number of live bands.

December 8 will be the start of the Canadian Legions series, which will feature Moxy and Crowbar.

Area residents can also rent Party Central for private functions such as Christmas parties, Buck and Does, banquets and weddings.

Mr. Pinto said the facility boasts a theatrical-looking stage, a horseshoe-shaped balcony and professional sound and lighting systems.

And anything people need for their party can be arranged by Mr. Pinto, who has 20 years experience in the promotion business.

"We put a package together," he said. "We can bring anybody in for as little or as much as they want to pay."

The venue is also available for promoters.
