

# Man killed in collision on Sunday

A two-car collision in rural Milton Sunday, killed one man and sent five others to hospital.

Christopher Stuckey, 34, of Acton, was pronounced dead at the scene.

At about 7:55 p.m., a 49-year-old Brantford woman was traveling south in a half-ton Dodge pickup truck on the Fifth Line in Milton when she entered the intersection at No. 25 sideroad hitting a Ford van that was traveling east.

The driver of the van, a 38-year-old Acton woman, was pinned in her vehicle and had to be removed by fire fighters and Halton Regional Police.

The woman was transferred to Milton District Hospital (MDH), before being airlifted to Sunnybrook Hospital. She was listed in critical condition.

The woman's 10-year-old daughter was also transferred to MDH before being airlifted to Sick Kids Hospital in Toronto. Her other child, a 13-year-old girl, was transported to Guelph General Hospital, where she was treated and released.

The driver of the Dodge was transported to MDH by ambulance before being transferred to Toronto Western Hospital. She was listed in serious condition.

Her 51-year-old passenger, also of Brantford, was transported to Guelph General Hospital, where he was treated and released.

The investigation is continuing.

# Mom wants plaque back

A plaque full of memories has been stolen off a railway trestle in Rotary Park.

A tiny gold plaque secured with four, four-inch screws has been pried off the trestle where Orlando Sonsogno, 23, hanged himself in May.

"It's very upsetting, I can't even reason it out," said Gina Sonsogno, mother of Mr. Sonsogno.

"Someone went to a lot of work to do that."

Mr. Sonsogno committed suicide after suffering from a severe depression. The plaque was put up to mark the place he killed himself, and provide a spot for mourners to pray or reflect on the man they knew and loved.

Ms Sonsogno has asked that the plaque be returned if found, or that any information regarding its disappearance be reported.
