*Oh,, what peace we often forfeit!*

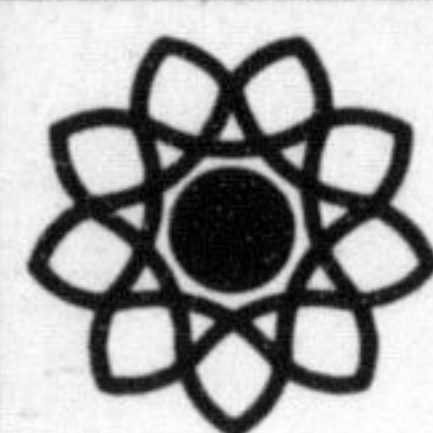
*Oh, what needless pain we bear!*

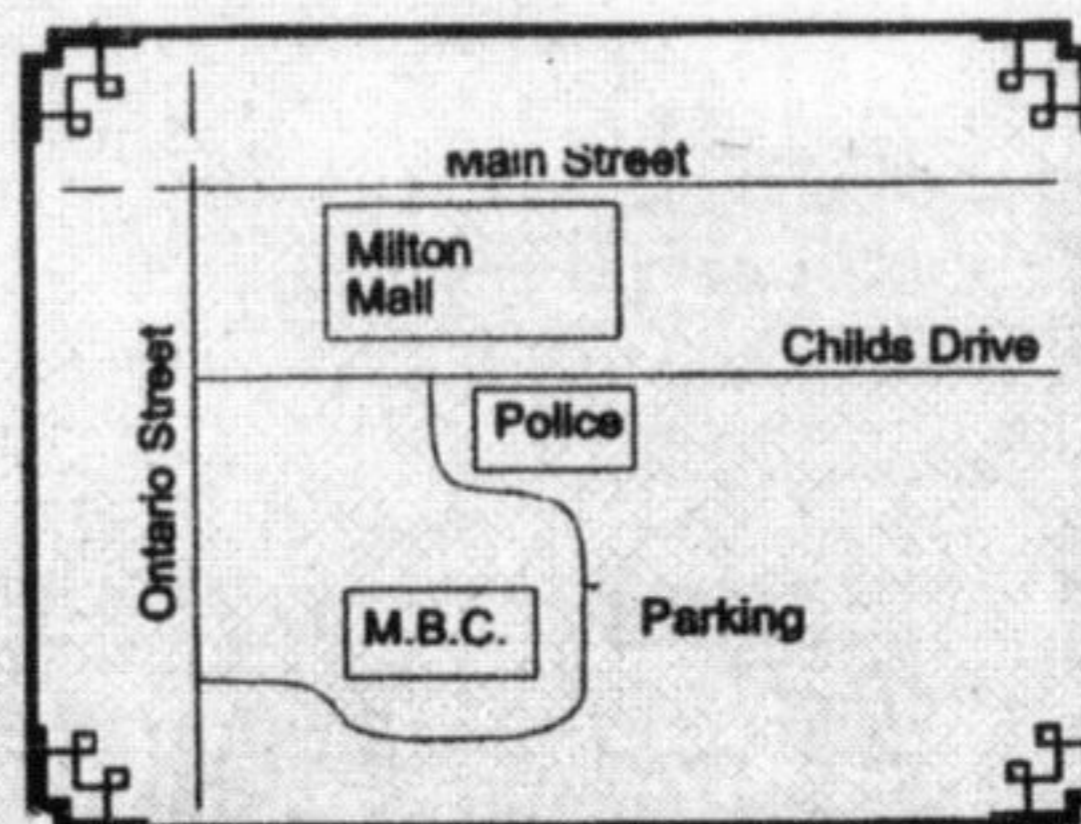
