

# BMXers shine in NY

Milton BMX racers had sweet rides recently in Bethel, Connecticut for the Northeast Region Championship/Yankee Nationals.

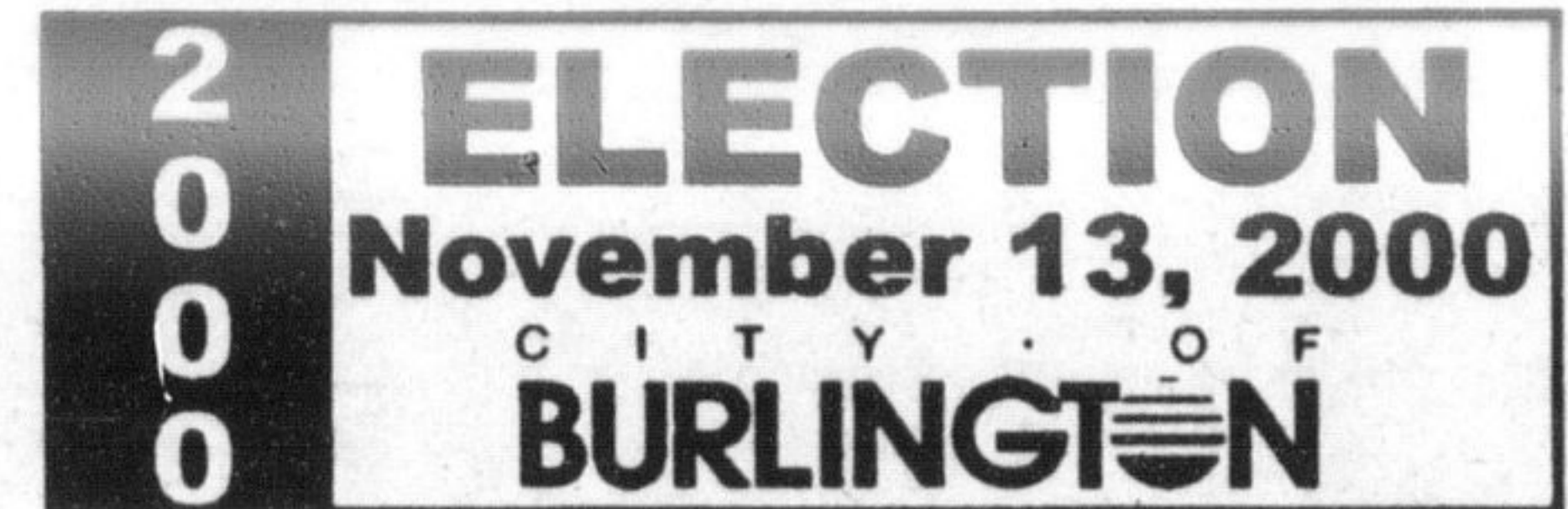
Bob Rowley, Canada's only AA pro BMX racer, delivered an amazing performance in the highest category of racing in the world. He took first overall in the main event on Saturday at the Yankee Nationals.

The goal for Alex Brancier — a 15-year-old in the novice division — was to qualify through the Northeast Region Championships for the U.S. Open Invitational on November 24 in

Morristown, Tennessee. He managed to do that and more. Racers have to qualify through the motos in order to make it to the main event, which Brancier did handily — finishing first, second and third.

In the main event, Brancier finished first, earning an automatic invitation to the U.S. Open Invitationals. He followed that up with more impressive results in the Yankee Nationals over the next two days. He finished second in the main event on Saturday and then had a perfect ride on Sunday, winning all three motos and then the main event.
