

Male suspect sought in indecent exposure incident

Halton Regional Police are looking for a man who exposed himself to two 14-year-old girls October 28.

The girls were walking on Ontario Street near Pitfield Street at about 1 p.m. when a man approached them from behind, running ahead.

The next time the girls saw him he was at a garbage shed with his pants down around his ankles, urinating.

The suspect then ran towards a park near the townhouse complex and began masturbating, Staff Sgt. Ron Welsh said.

The police were called and the area was searched, but the suspect had disappeared.

Police are looking for a white male in his early '20s with a portly build. He was wearing a three-quarter length green army-type trench coat and a green fishing-style hat.

Suspicious vehicle

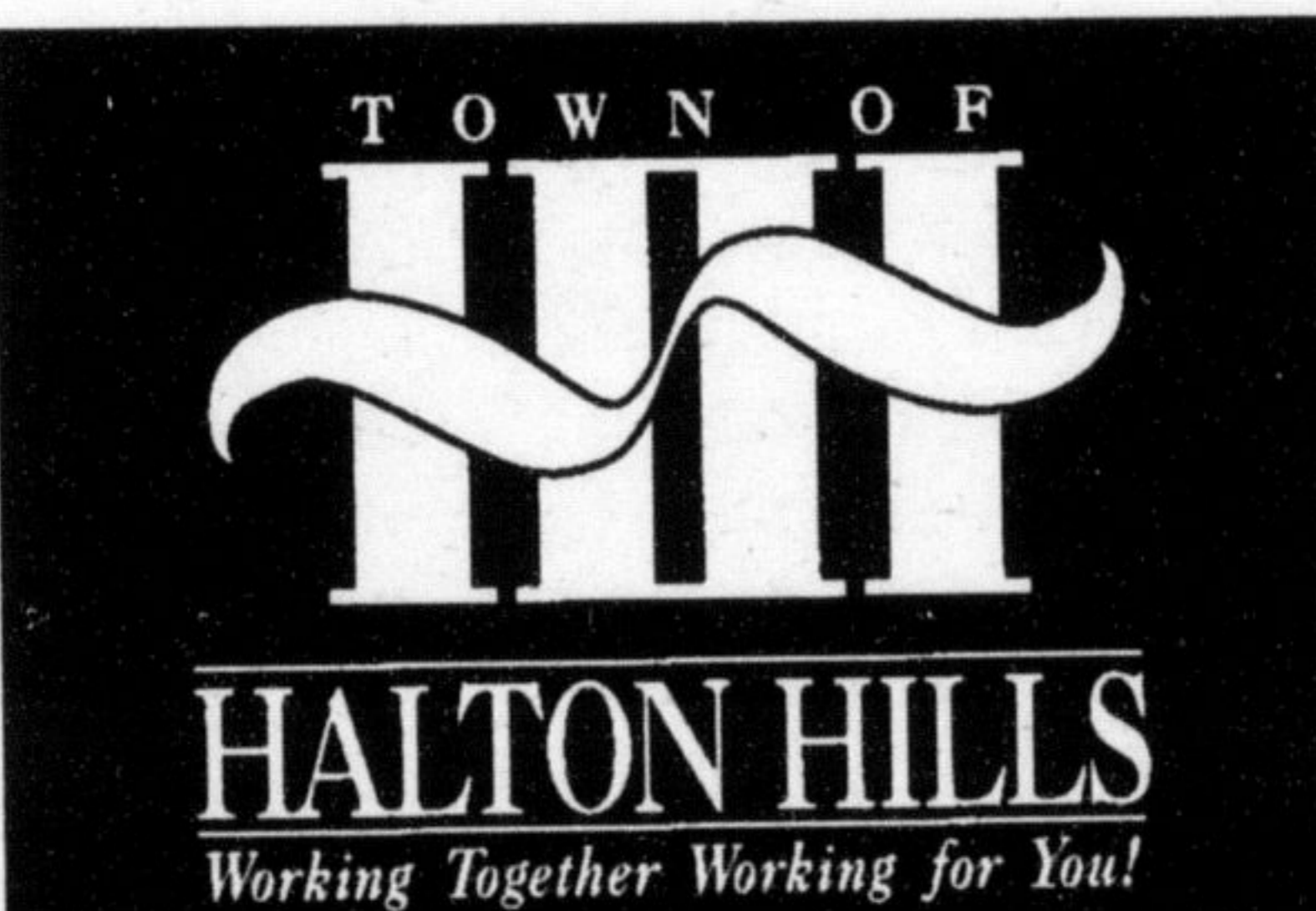
