Today - I can complain because I have to go to school, or eagerly open my mind and fill it with rich new tidbits of knowledge.

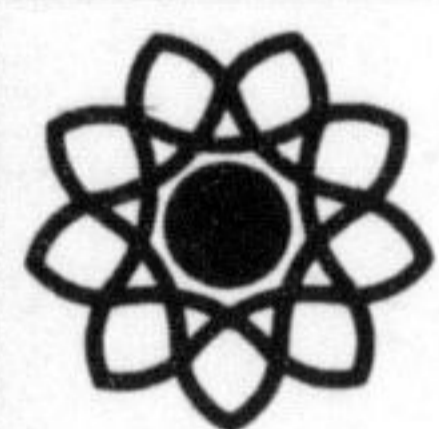
Today - I can murmur dejectedly because I have to do housework, or I can feel honored because God has provided me shelter for my mind body and soul.

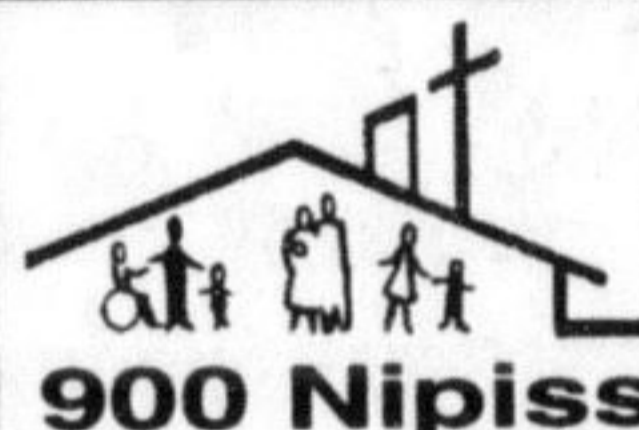
