Local ladies lose another

The victory party will have to wait for another night.

Milton's ladies hockey team had hoped to break into the win column at home against shortstuffed Brantford Tuesday. Instead, they were left with another case of heartbreak.

Within the confines of Memorial Arena, Jim Lane's charges delivered a fairly respectable effort for much of the evening clash — but a lack of finish and second-period letdown cost them to lose 5-1.

Following a scoreless opening frame, the visitors potted three goals inside eight minutes — two by way of short-range rebounds — to essentially take the game.

Karen Brown had the lone goal for Milton.

It came on a goal-mouth scramble in the final minute of the second, with Linda Knight drawing an assist on the play.

Brantford delivered a backbreaking fourth goal early in the third on a three-on-one rush and then added insult to injury by scoring again with just half-a-minute remaining.

Overall, Michelle Norton faced 29 shots. She came up with some big glove and kick saves to keep the final tally within the realm of respectability.

Not that she didn't get some help from her blueline unit — although most of it came in the first period. Highlighting this defensively tight stretch was a nifty goal-mouth tie-up by Tanya Crippin and a two-on-one break-up by Anita Mastracci — who also led the offensive efforts with at least seven shots.

Milton fared much better the week before on home ice where they donned their rally caps and battled back to tie Niagara Falls 2-2.

After falling behind early, the local squad stymied their fast-skating guests through the final two periods en route to their comeback draw.

Rebecca Walters deposited both goals for Milton. Assisting on each was Susan Cameron while Norton was sharp between the pipes.
