Everlasting Father

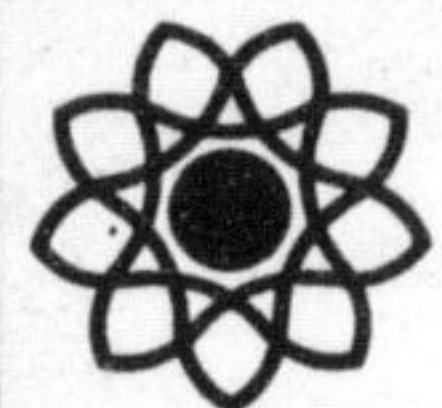
He is without begin and without end. He was born as a child at Christmas, but existed in eternity long before that. He had no beginning and He has no end!
