## Too soon to tell if bill will raise residential property taxes here

A provincial bill aimed at equalizing the tax share between commercial, residential, multiresidential and industrial classes is poised to pass in Queen's Park.

But it's too soon to tell if Bill 140 will lead to hikes in residential property taxes.

Typically, residential properties are taxed at a lesser rate than business classes.

In Halton, for example, commercial taxes come in at 1.4 per cent higher than residential, while industrial assessment is 2.5 times higher.

Bill 140 aims to achieve parity between the classes in order to foster economic growth, said Halton MPP Ted Chudleigh.

Funds were raised through the foundation's golf tournament as well as the sale of t-shirts and Christmas cards.





