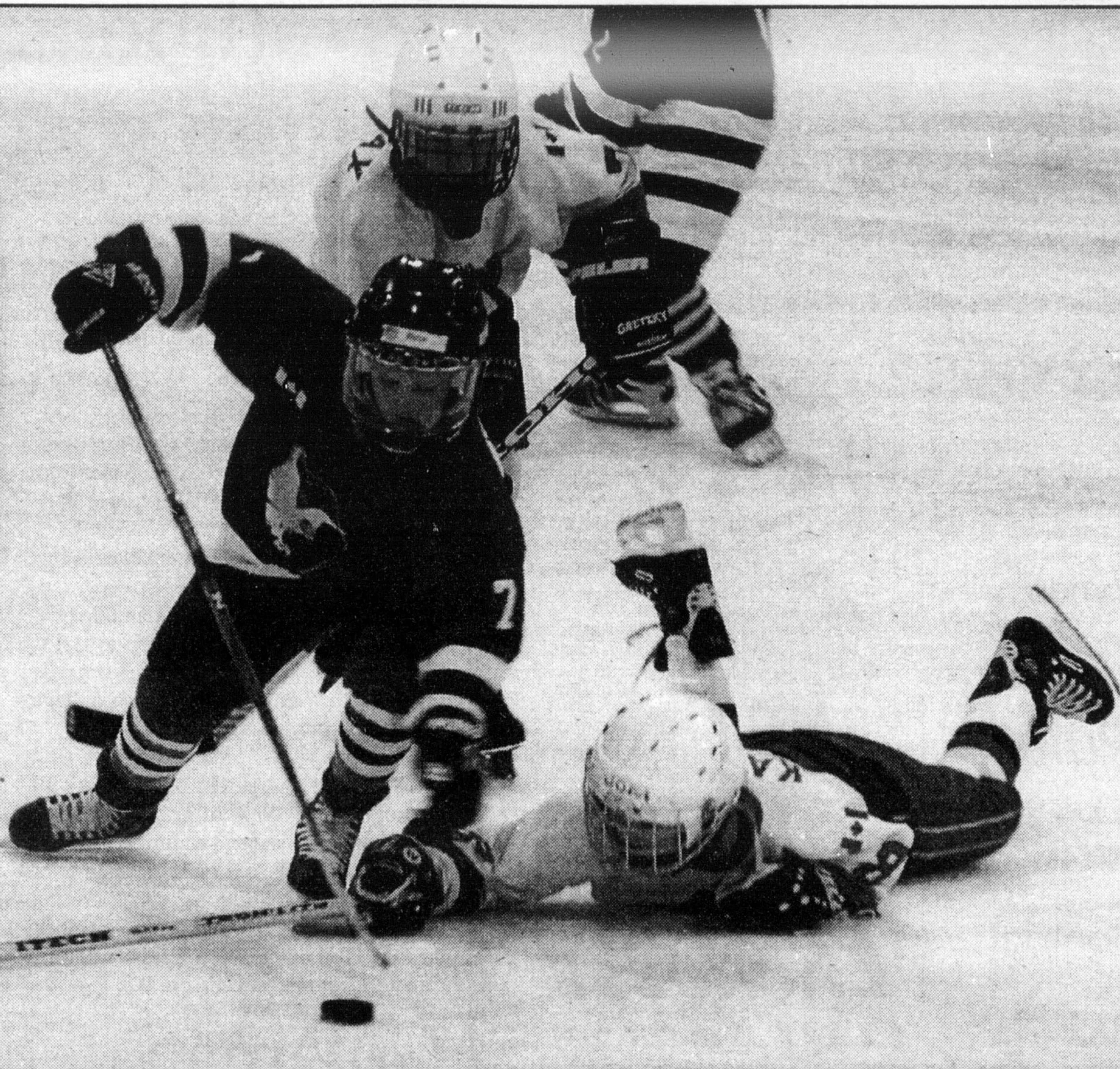


# Hawks grounded

# Juveniles earn revenge with victory over Ajax

Revenge may be a dish best served cold, but Milton's AA juveniles were red hot when it came time for payback in Ajax Tuesday.

John Arnold's contingent avenged three previous losses, including a home-ice massacre just two weeks ago, by upstaging the gritty Knights 6-4.

Third-period goals by Jordan Jeans and Matt Ventura — who drew a pair of assists earlier in the night for his biggest offensive output this season — lifted the Winterhawks to victory and extended their current undefeated streak to four games.

Sharing the spotlight with a hat-trick in the middle stanza was Jeff Mitchell. Josh Arnold was steady between the pipes for his second win in four nights while netting the visitors' first tally was Derek Mewhinney.

Picking up assists in the win — which was marked by the return of suspended captain Steve Szafer — were Jeans, Mitchell, Derek Birnie, Paul Faggion and Ricky Nadalin.

The highly confrontational showdown was cut short due to an 11 p.m. curfew, but

with less than seven minutes remaining and Milton in control it appeared there would be no hometown comeback anyway.

Two days earlier in Bradford, Milton was severely short-staffed and had to settle for a 4-4 stalemate.

Just nine skaters started the afternoon clash and the ranks were further depleted when Marco Labello succumbed to a minor injury on the second shift.

### Gutsy effort

The Winterhawks rallied from two third-period deficits to eke out the draw. Mewhinney capped a three-goal showcase with the final tying tally while also scoring in the final frame was Mitchell, who drew a pair of helpers as well.

Recording single assists were Faggion, Rod Heinz, Dave Kornack, Chad Merritt and Chris Wulfers.

Netminder Chris Kovachik replaced Arnold after goal number two midway through the game and delivered one of his finest performance this season.

The 9-5-3 Winterhawks will be on the road tonight against Noble-King and will close out the calendar year tomorrow evening at home versus Stouffville. Game time is 8:30 p.m.

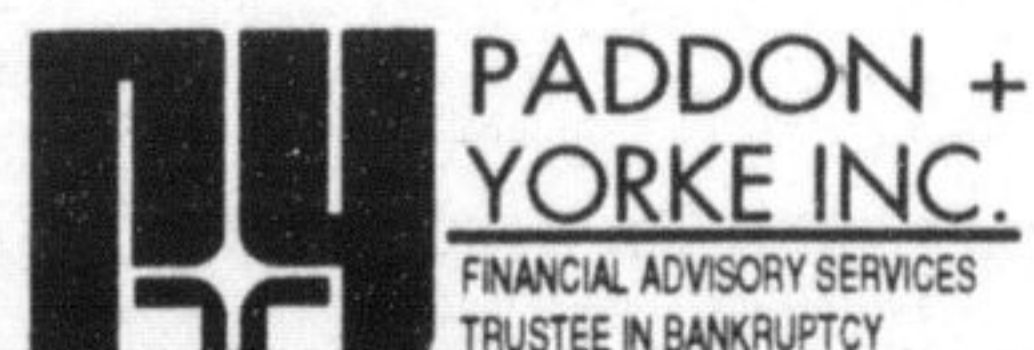
