

## Milton veterans invited to annual appreciation dinner

When war broke out in the last century, many young Canadian soldiers answered the call to serve.

But on January 29, veterans of those wars will just have to answer the call to dinner instead.

All Milton vets of the First and Second World Wars and the Korean War have been invited to the second annual veteran's appreciation dinner.

Food will be prepared by a team of professional chefs who have represented the province in chef competitions.

Members of the RCMP, replete in their classic red serge uniforms, will also be on hand at the event which is aimed at thanking the former soldiers for their courage and service in combat.

The event is put on by several local service clubs, including the Lions, Kinsmen, Rotary and Knights of Columbus, in partnership with branch 136 of the Royal Canadian Legion.

"They'll supply the manpower, food and lots of donated time," said Pat Kelly, an organizer of the dinner.

Last year, about 80 veterans came out for the feast

Organizers are anxious to ensure all veterans have the opportunity to attend the free event, but

the numbers have to be booked in advance.

"We really need to settle on a number of veterans," said Mr. Kelly.

So organizers are asking any veterans, whether they be Legion members or not, to contact Ed Osborne between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. to confirm their attendance.

The location of the dinner hasn't yet been selected, but the evening is meant to kick off at 5 p.m.
