Milton squad earns revenge against Forest in tightly-contested finals to take title

Pay back was ever so sweet for Milton's Royal Canadian Legion Br. #136 curling team recently in Blenheim.

Less than a day after falling to Forest, Ken Armstrong's rink avenged the loss and in the process captured the men's open provincial title, the first for Milton.

Championship action saw the local skip play the freeze and limit his opposition to just a single point in the fifth end - which turned the tables on the match and allowed his squad to come away with a 9-6 10th end victory.

This capped a thoroughly exhausting week for the eventual winners, who were taken to the limit in every game.

"We felt we were the best team there, but we made it tough on ourselves," said

Armstrong, whose team tied for second place a couple of years ago.

Milton won six of seven matches at the tournament and finished with an overall shooting percentage of 85.7.

Vice Dave Hannon, second Dave MacLeod and lead Ron Brown comprise the rest of the championship foursome whose other provincial victims included Alliston, Brighton, Callander, Fergus and Kingston.

Armstrong's rink will now test its mettle at the national level March 17 to 24 in Sommerside, PEI.
