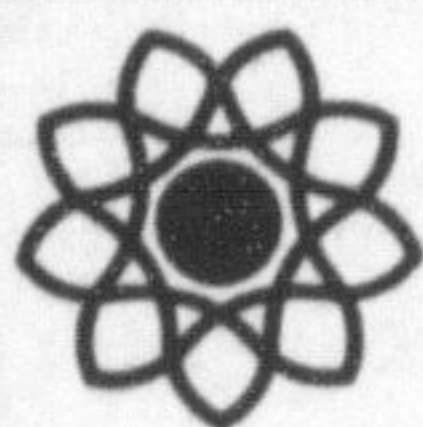
Often, tough times make us tougher!
