

# CARP hosts essay contest for youths

The Halton chapter of Canada's Association for the Fifty Plus (CARP) will hold its second annual Intergeneration Contest open to all secondary school students in Halton.

In September, details of the contest were given to the Halton District School Board and the Halton Catholic District School Board as well as St. Mildred's and Appleby, two independent schools in Halton.

Students were asked to write an essay outlining an experience or discussion with a grandparent or someone else over the age of 50.

Each of the 24 secondary schools within Halton are asked to submit one entry to the Halton chapter by March 31.

The judges will select the first, second and third-place entries.

Entries will be judged by Regional Chairman Joyce Marni Rev. Savoline, Nancekivell of Saint Aidan's Anglican Church in Oakville, Rev. Donna Howlett of Tansley United Church in Burlington and Merna Dack and Ken Laramie of the Halton chapter of CARP.

The three winners, along with school representatives, parents and grandparents will be invited to the Halton chapter meeting May 23 when prizes of \$300 for first, \$200 for second and \$100 for third-place will be awarded.


