A parable is told of a wise farmer who owned an old mule. One day, the old mule fell into an abandoned well and in overwhelming despair, began to bray, calling out for help from the depths of the dark hole. The wise farmer heard the old mule's cry and immediately ran over to help. It was not long before that old mule, battered and exhausted, stepped triumphantly over the wall of that well. What seemed like it would bury him, actually blessed him... all because of the manner in which he handled his adversity.


In life, we must learn to face problems positively. We




