Anti-racism celebration to be held Wednesday

The North Halton Cultural Awareness Council (N.H.C.A.C.) invites the public to help celebrate the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination Wednesday.

The N.H.C.A.C. will recognize several Halton community members committed to promoting cultural and racial understanding at the Town of Halton Hills Cultural Centre, 9 Church St., in Georgetown at 7

Awards will be given in a number of areas, including the field of education, police service, media, community work and others.

This is the first of what is intended as an annual event to recognize the high level of commitment to promoting cultural and racial awareness among Halton community members.

While in recent years many Halton residents have received recognition outside of the region for their tireless efforts, the N.H.C.A.C. has decided it's time to recognize these efforts locally.

The evening will feature a keynote address by retired Halton Regional Police chief James Harding followed by the awards presentation and refreshments.

The award winners won't be announced prior to the presentation.

The special day was proclaimed by the United Nations in 1966 to commemorate the ultimate sacrifice made by 69 peace protesters who were killed in 1960 during a demonstration against apartheid in South Africa. It's also a symbol of a world-wide need to end racism.

In 1989, Canada demonstrated its support for the United Nation's declaration by launching its first national 'March 21' campaign.


