• from ALL-DAY on page 1 dimension of the kindergarten experience," added Ms Gardiner. "Other important issues are the material in the curriculum and quality teaching. I have no doubt

our program will be exceptional." Shelly Easton was the lone delegation supporting the all-day, alternate-day JK schedule, having experienced it in the mid-'90s.

"The experience was an unequivocal success," said the Burlington parent. "My son loved it and, as a parent, I appreciated the convenience and flexibility the model provided to organize school, daycare, work and home life."

Ms Easton said the all-day system has many supporters and services will adapt to meet new daycare needs. She said it would be irresponsible to spend money on busing for half-day programs.

"I and dozens of others like me

want our education dollars spent on programs and people in the schools who will aid our children."

But the all-day schedule was roundly criticized by six other delegations at the marathon meeting.

"These programs should not be just for those with the luxury of being stay-at-home parents, having flexible schedules or a spouse who can help out," said Bonnie Easterbrook. "This proposal brings a whole new set of problems."

Gillian Linbrook parent Santangeli cited studies showing all-day kindergarten leads to decreased academic competence, poorer social skills due to increased fatigue, less actual teaching time and less accurate assessments by teachers.

"This model is a big unknown for many of us, the logistical implications have not been clearly resolved and there is the appear-

ance financial constraints are taking precedence over the well-being of our children," noted Ms Santangeli.
