

Safety guide for seniors

Halton Regional Police have released Taking Care — A Safety Guide for Seniors, which provides information to seniors and their caregivers on topics relating to safety and crime prevention.

The guide's 'Our Personal Safety' section provides information on how to be secure in your home, what to watch out for in the community and what you should be aware of when walking to or sitting in your vehicle.

Information on the latest scams, such as the 'lottery scam' and the 'charity scam'

are mentioned as well.

The last section deals with elder abuse, a "quiet safety issue" that many seniors face.

It's estimated that more than 4 per cent of Ontario's 1.45 million seniors suffer from some form of abuse. The safety guide describes how to spot abuse and stop it from happening, whether it be physical or financial.

Copies of the safety guide can be picked up at the Milton police station and Allendale.

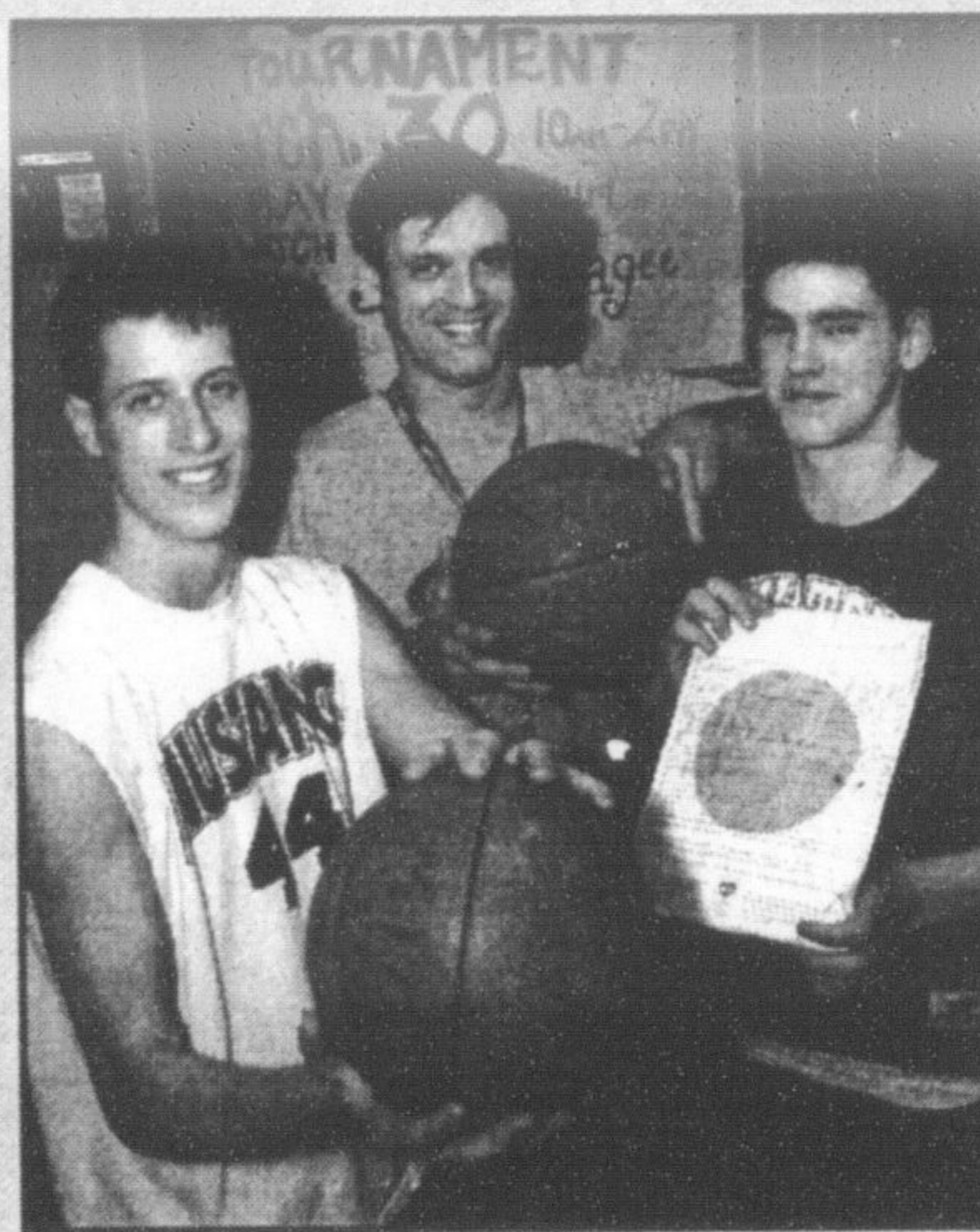
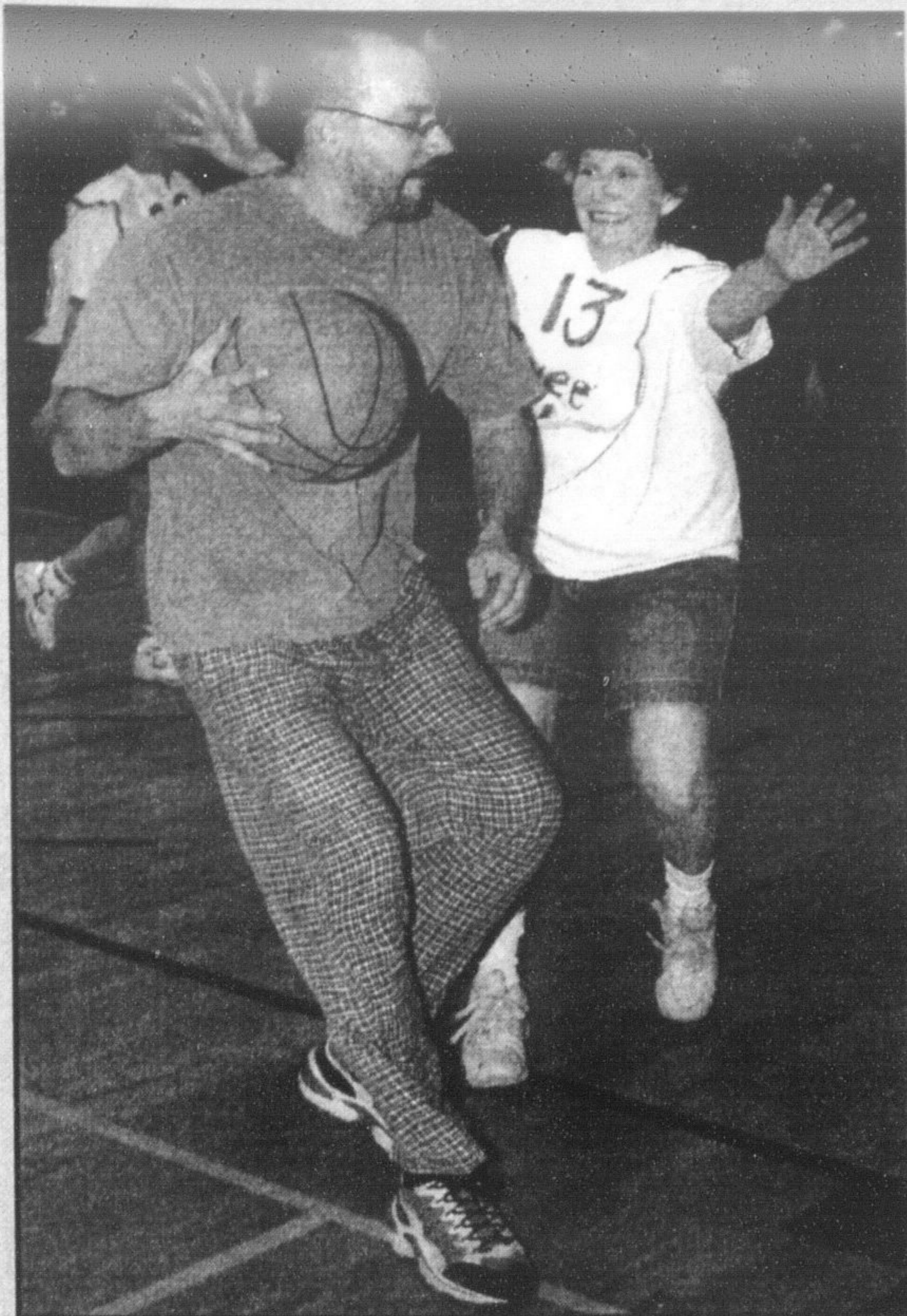

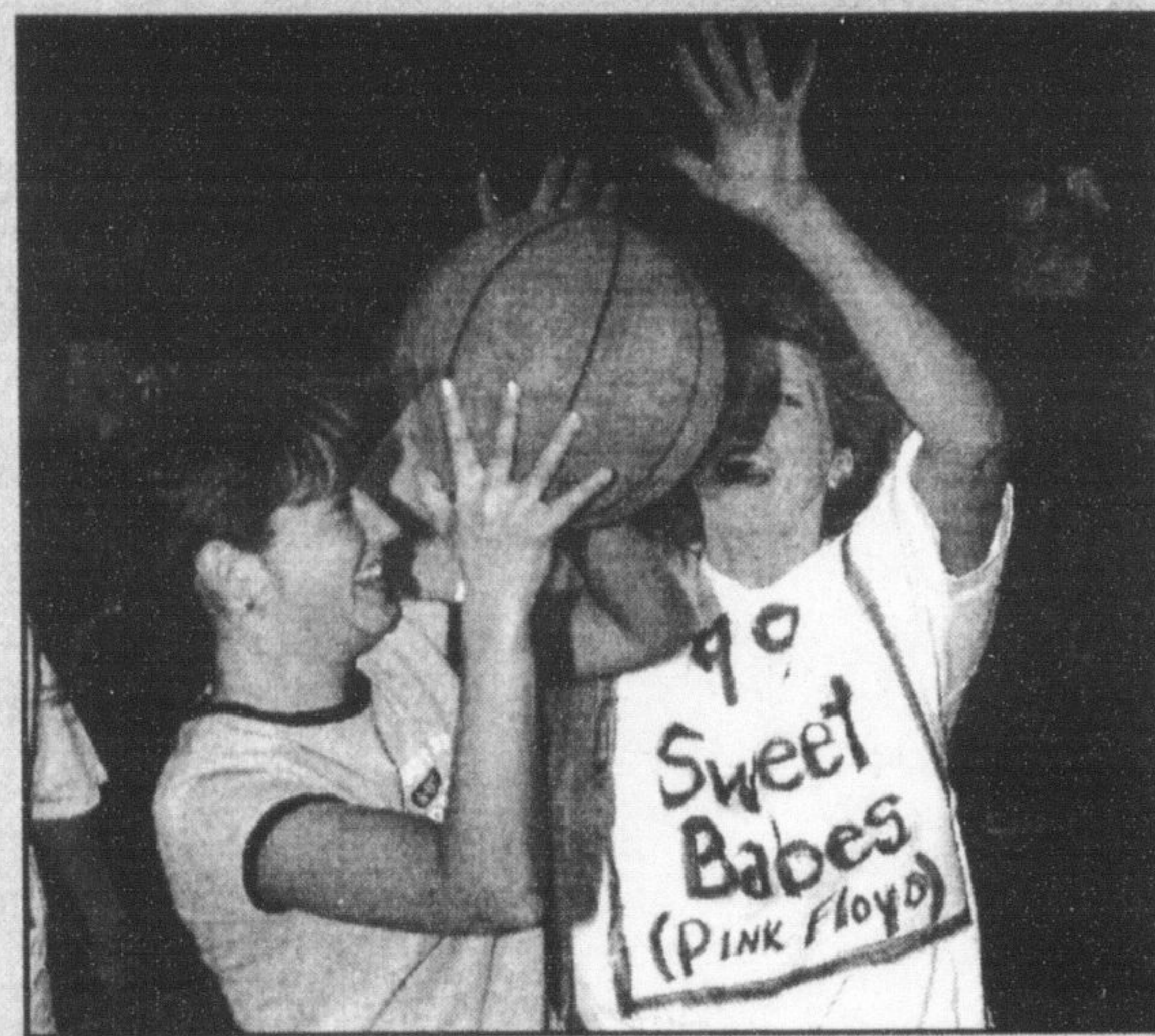
