

Milton gets two more officers

Milton will soon have two more police officers on the beat.

Christopher Gruber and Tamara Tait will join the local ranks following today's swearing in ceremony at regional headquarters in Oakville.

Mr. Gruber and Ms Tait — who reside in Burlington and Toronto respectively — are among 13 new officers joining the Halton Regional Police Service.

Burlington and Oakville will each get four new recruits while

three have been assigned to Halton Hills.

This latest group is somewhat unique in that eight of its members have previous policing experience and two of the rookies are married to each other.

OPP targets lane offences

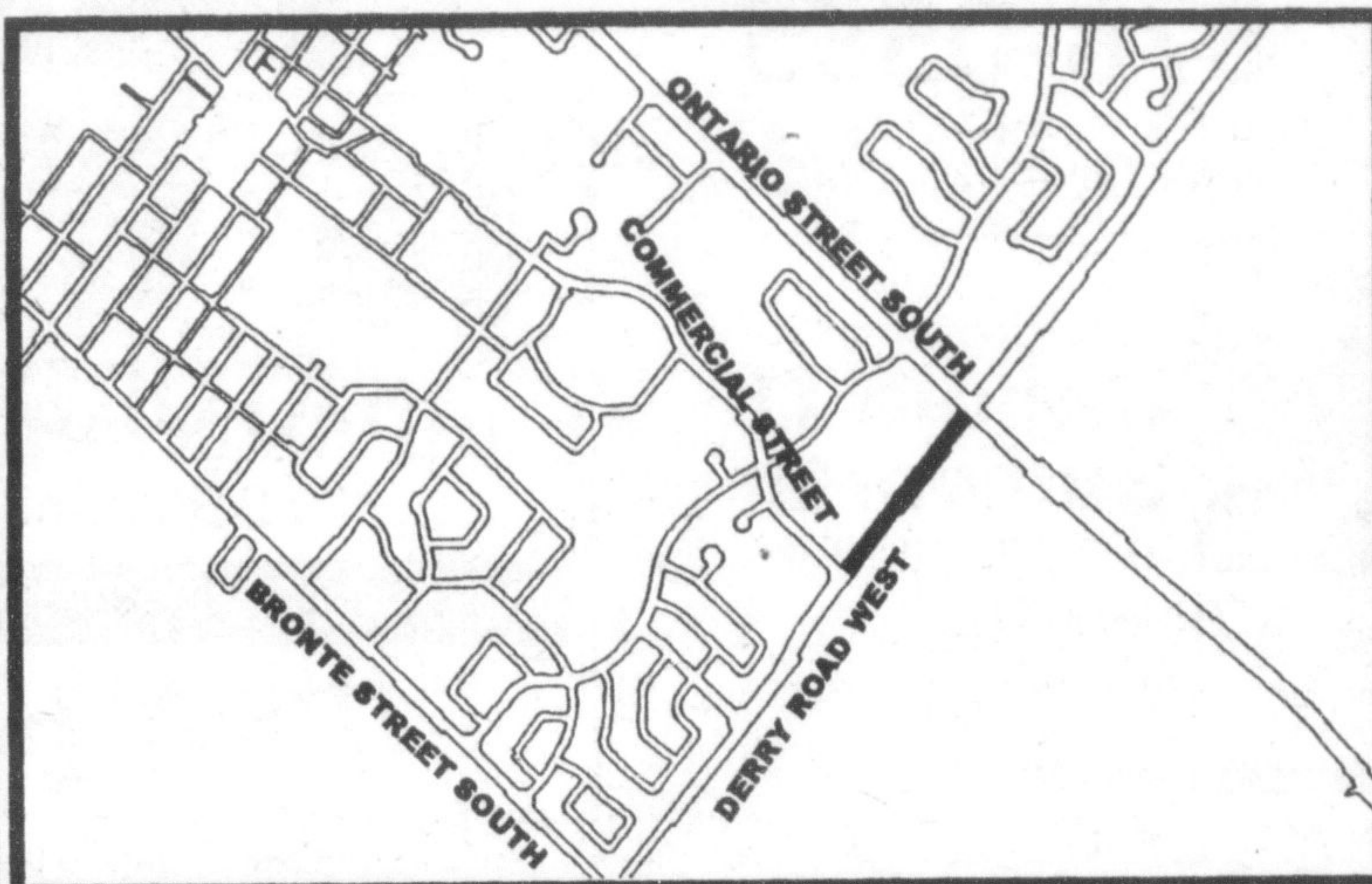
