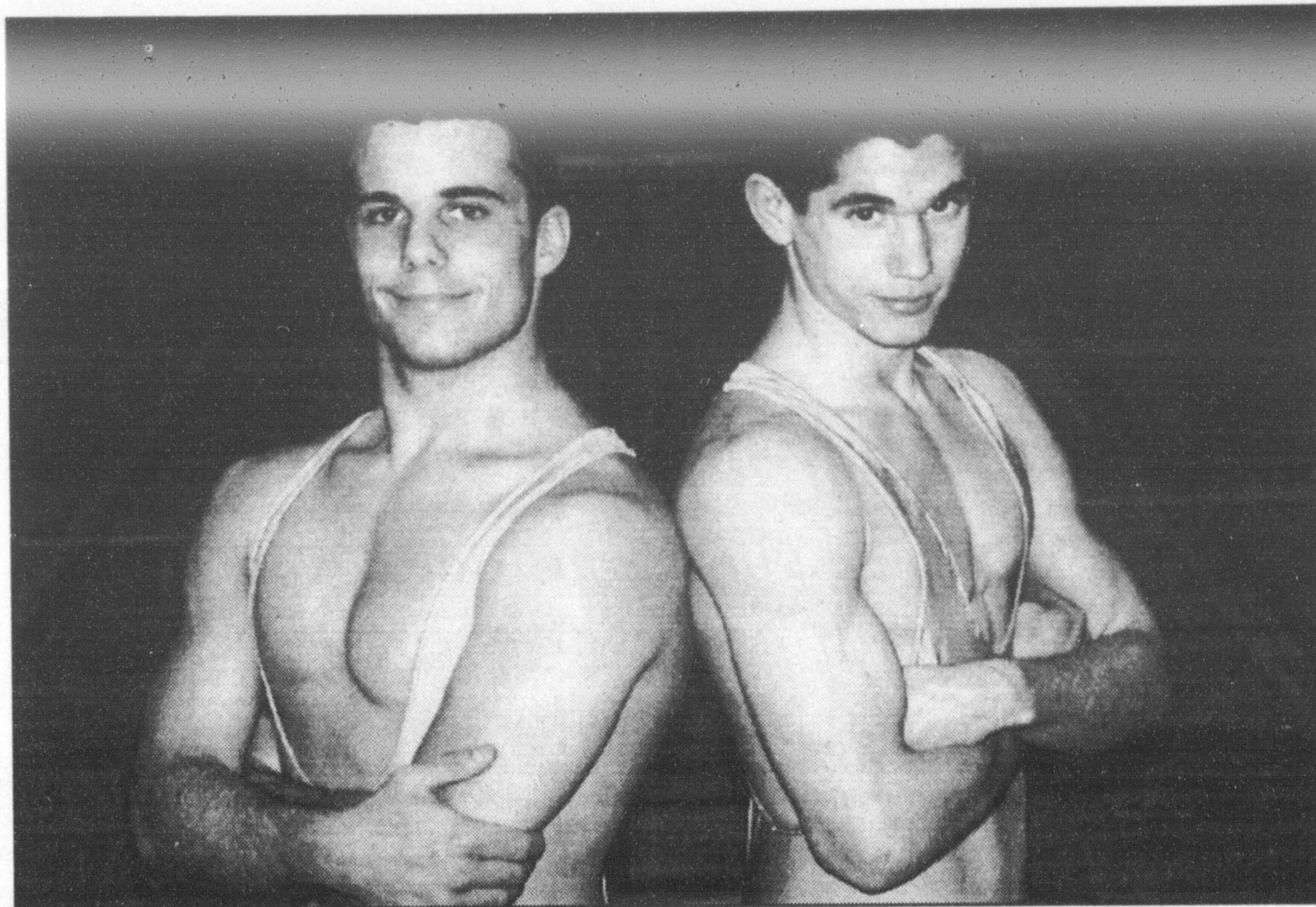

## Spartans shine at nationals

E.C. Drury High School's celebrated wrestling team capped a stellar season with a little national prominence last weekend in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

Spartans Adam Baxter and Matt Knock — both members of the 2001 OFSAA winning squad — each delivered top five finishes during the Canadian Cadet-Juvenile Championships.

Knock steamrolled through his cadet class competition on day one — securing four dominant victories — before dropping a slim semifinal decision to eventual gold medalist Jake LeDoux of Oshawa.

Not fully recovered from this heartbreaking defeat, he then gave a somewhat uninspiring performance and lost to Calgary's Andrew Hope.

Refusing to end things off on a negative note, the sophomore grappler refocused his energies on a final encounter with Winnipeg's Jeff Silver — and triumphed in commanding fashion.

This brought his team-leading season win total to 41.

Meanwhile, Baxter also provided a strong season finish by winning three matches in the freestyle division and grabbing fifth spot in the Greco-Roman wrestling loop.

In the latter, he prevailed in his first two matches before being out pointed by freestyle silver medalist Joe Bentley of Calgary.

Baxter then came up short against Saskatchewan's Jarrett Shanderuk — after a couple of near falls — but rebounded to blank Nova Scotia's Michael Moody 11-0 in the battle for fifth.

An OFSAA fifth-place finisher as well, he ended the year with a 37 victories and surpassed the 100-win plateau for his career.

Also competing for Drury and winning matches in the cadet division were Jesse Ronan and Colin Burnham — who went 2-2 and 1-2 respectively during their national debuts.
