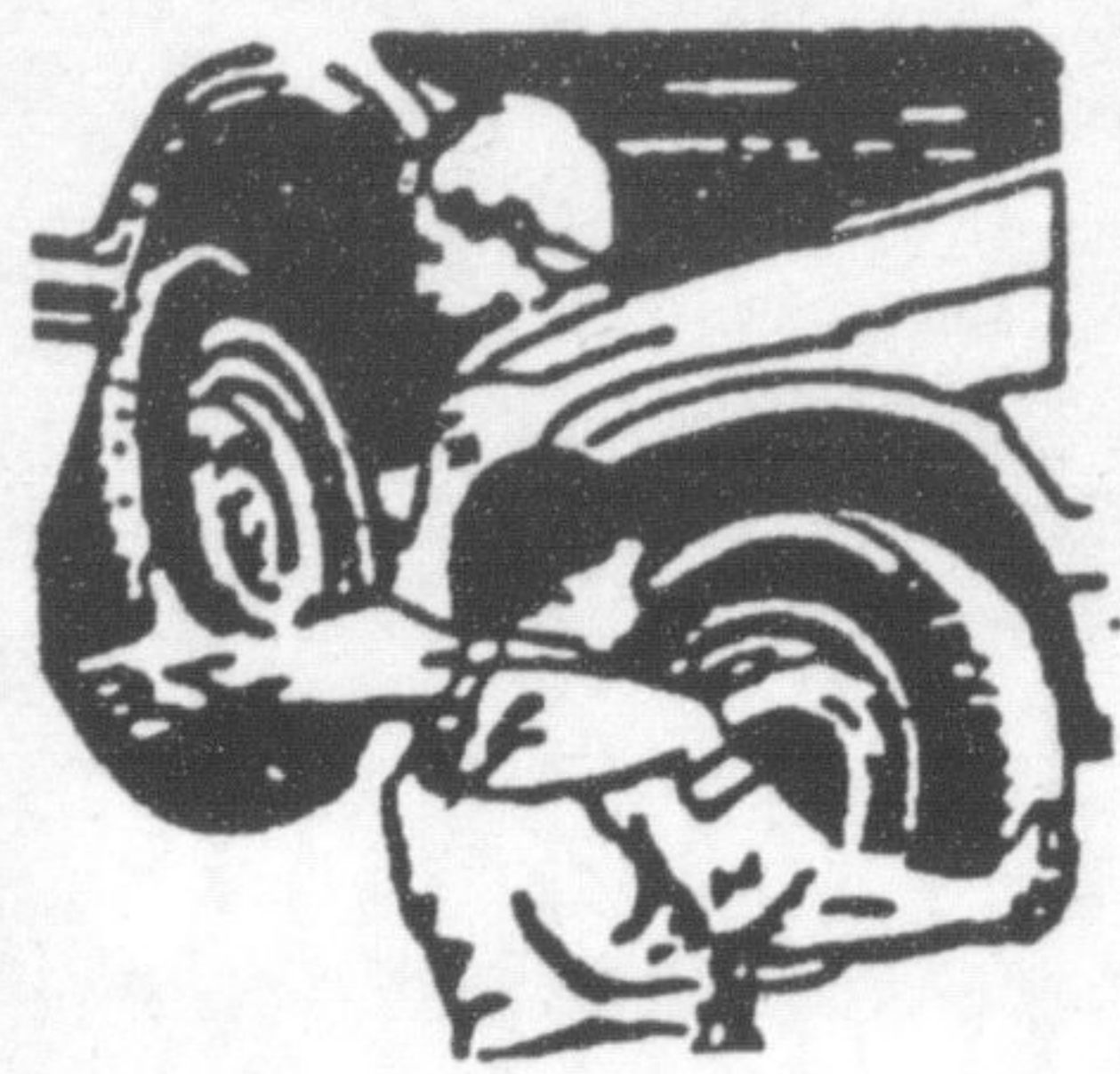

TAX NOTICE

Ratepayers of the Town of Milton are reminded that the 2nd installment of the Interim Tax Bill is due on April 30/2001.

If you require information about taxes, please contact the Corporate Services Tax Development at (905) 878-7252, ext. 2393, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Tax payments must be received in the Corporate Services Office on or before the due date to avoid penalty. Late payment charge of 1 1/4% will be charged on the first day of default and on the first day of each calendar month in which the default continues. It is the responsibility of the ratepayer to ensure that the taxes are paid by the due date, even in the event that the bill is not received as mailed.

Taxes may be paid:

- a) By mail to the Corporate Services Tax Department, 43 Brown St., Milton ON L9T 5H2.

Cheques post-dated to the due date are acceptable and encouraged.

- b) By phone if you bank with Canada Trust, TD Bank, CIBC, Royal Bank or Bank of Montreal. Please call them for detail.
- c) By using the mail deposit box to the left of the glass doors at Town Hall.
- d) Between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Corporate Services Tax Department, Town Hall, 43 Brown Street, Milton. (Cheque or money orders preferred rather than cash). Direct Debit now accepted.
- e) Please contact our office for details regarding the "New" pre-authorized tax payment program.

NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with The Weed Control Act R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5, Sections 3, 13, 14, 16 and 23 that, unless weed seeds and noxious weeds growing on their lands within the Town of Milton are destroyed by the date of June 15th, 2001 and throughout the season, the Town of Milton may enter upon the said lands and have the weeds destroyed, charging the costs against the land in taxes as set out in The Weed Control Act.

The co-operation of all property owners is earnestly solicited. Complaints and inquiries may be made by telephone, to the number listed below. Please note that dandelions, burdock and gold-enrod are not considered noxious weeds within the Town of Milton under the Weed Control Act; therefore, complaints concerning these weeds or any anonymous complaints cannot be accepted.
