Students at Robert Baldwin School celebrated Earth Day April 24 with the help of many community supporters.

A ceremony, which included Mayor Gord Krantz, was held in the newly-landscaped Peace Gardens, which were expanded this year with the creation of the Butterfly Meadow.

Red Maple and Linden trees were donated by the Milton Kinsmen Club.

Students joined parents in a clean-up of the school yard. Consumers Glass donated reusable gloves to every student in the school for pick-up.

And the Town of Milton continued its ongoing support by consulting with planning stages, delivering and moving boulders for the garden, clearing sod for the Butterfly Meadow, digging holes for planting trees and staking trees to ensure protection while growing.
