The Junior Duet/Trios also had a clean sweep with their dance numbers Shake It, We Like To Party and If You Can't Rock Me.

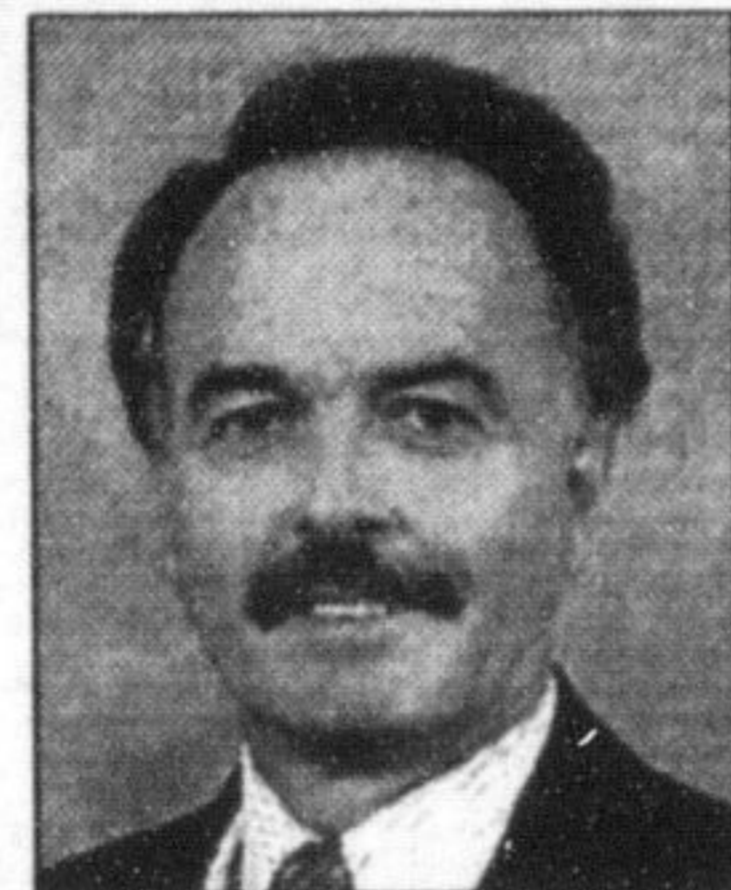
Michelle McArthur and Laurie Cameron placed first and third overall, respectively, in the Junior Solo competition.

The Dance Shoppe dancers also placed first for overall Teen and overall Senior competition.

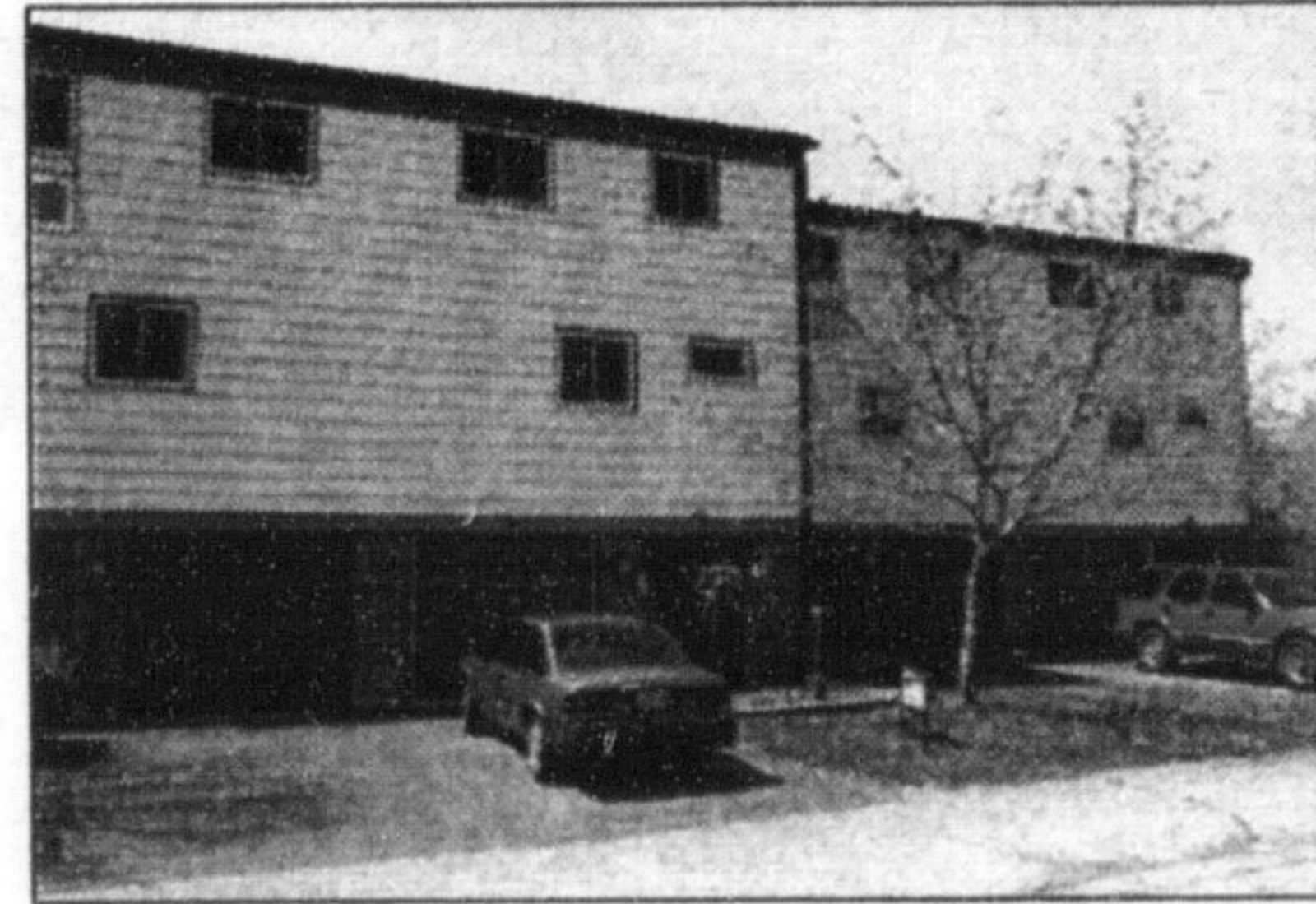
Teachers Cristina Carubia and Ruth-Ann Gray were both awarded for Best Choreography in two different age categories. Ms Carubia

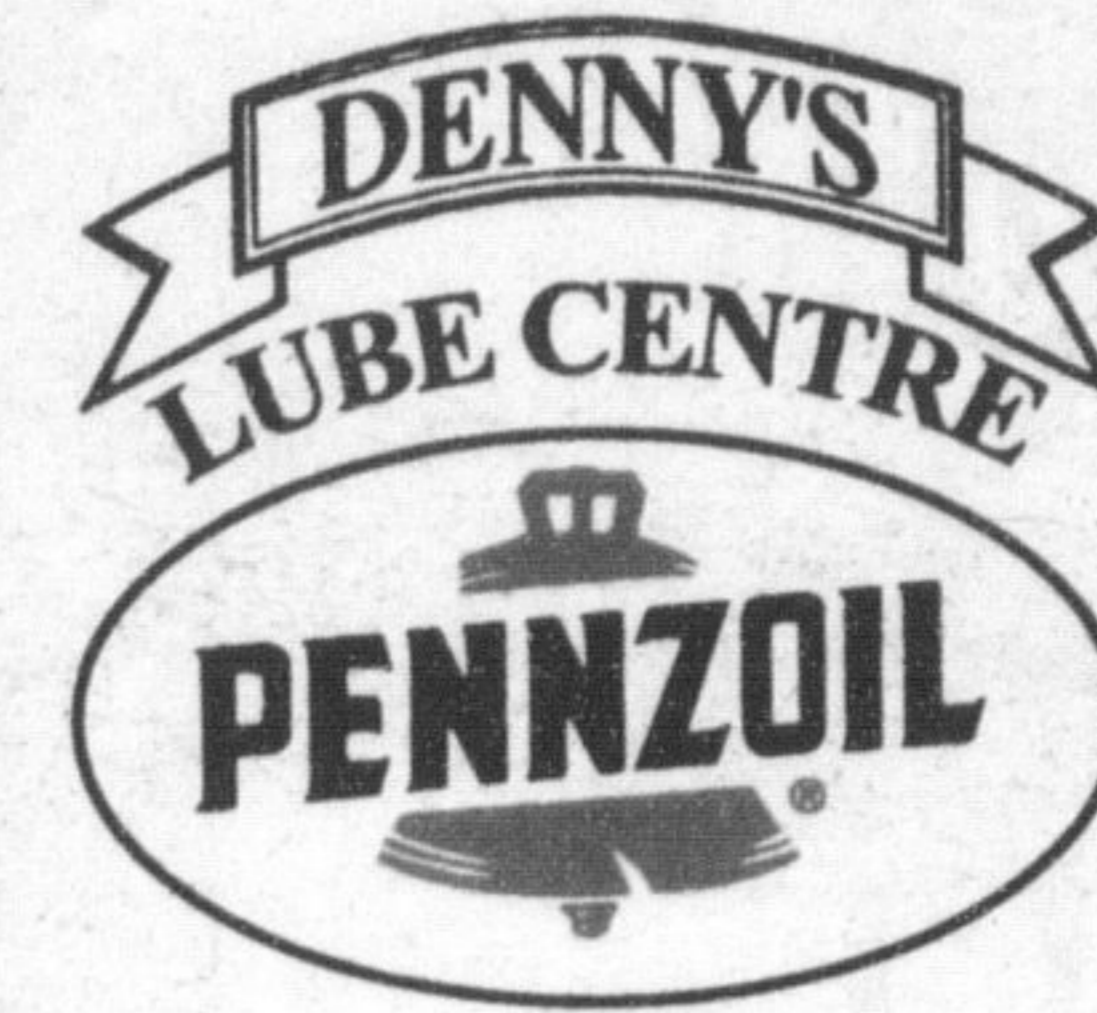
