


Notice of a Public Meeting 401 CORRIDOR INTEGRATED PLANNING PROJECT TEMPORARY USE BY-LAW DEVELOPMENT "D" ZONE

Council for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss a proposed temporary Zoning By-law Amendment for the 401 Corridor Secondary Plan Area.

Town Council adopted the 401 Corridor Integrated Planning Project in March 2000 which includes a Secondary Plan as well as Urban Design Guidelines, Scoped Subwatershed Study, and Implementing Official Plan Amendment.

On June 19, 2000, the Town passed Zoning By-Law 00-076. This By-Law placed the lands subject to O.P.A. #94 into a "Development (D) Zone" for a one year period pending the completion of a comprehensive Zoning By-Law for the 401 Corridor. Subsequently, the Town passed Zoning By-Law 00-138 for the 401 Corridor on October 23, 2000. This By-Law has been appealed to the Ontario Municipal Board. Until the OMB rules on the appeals, it is proposed that a Temporary Use By-Law be passed to recognize the future development of the lands, however, in the interim, it only permits uses by a public authority and uses legally existing at the date of passing of the By-Law.

The purpose of the public meeting is to provide more information regarding the By-Law to zone the area as Development "D" Zone. Planning staff will provide additional information at the Public Meeting. The public is invited to attend the meeting to ask questions and provide comments. If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the approved authority does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting, or make written submissions before a decision, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss the appeal.

Milton District Hospital is now \$131,000 richer thanks to the hospital's Auxiliary.


Auxiliary president Grace Hildebrand presented the donation to the hospital May 17 during the fundraising organization's annual meeting.
