## Sam Sherratt School gets funding from Grassroots for information technology

Students are learning about information technology with help from the Grassroots project.

Eight Halton public schools will receive a total of nearly \$45,000 for participating in the project.

"Grassroots is a terrific opportunity for schools to connect curriculum and technology in the classroom," said Mary Taylor, the Halton District School Board's instructional technologies coordinator.
