**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING
PROPOSED OFFICIAL PLAN AND ZONING
BY-LAW AMENDMENTS
- RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITIES**

Council for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss proposed amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning by-laws of the Town with regard to residential care facilities. Residential care facilities are defined as residential facilities in which residents who have a range of emotional, psychiatric, physical, developmental, or social disadvantages or problems live in a 24-hour supervised setting, and receive both room and board support with daily living. Residential care facilities include group homes.

The purpose of the proposed Official Plan and Zoning by-law amendments is to establish planning policies and regulations that will continue to permit residential care facilities, while ensuring that they are registered and appropriately located and distributed within the Town of Halton Hills. The amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning by-laws will apply to the Town of Halton Hills as a whole.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed Official Plan and Zoning by-law amendments does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan and Zoning by-law amendments are adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

Copies of the Final Report of the Halton Hills Residential Care Facilities Study, including the proposed Official Plan and Zoning by-law amendments will be available for public review and comment from May 23, 2001 in the Town of Halton Hills Planning Department.

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan and Zoning by-law amendments, you must make a written request to the Planning Department, Town of Halton Hills, 1 Halton Hills Drive, P.O. Box 128, Halton Hills (Georgetown), L7G 5G2.
