NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Fourth Line/Glenorchy Environmental Assessment Study

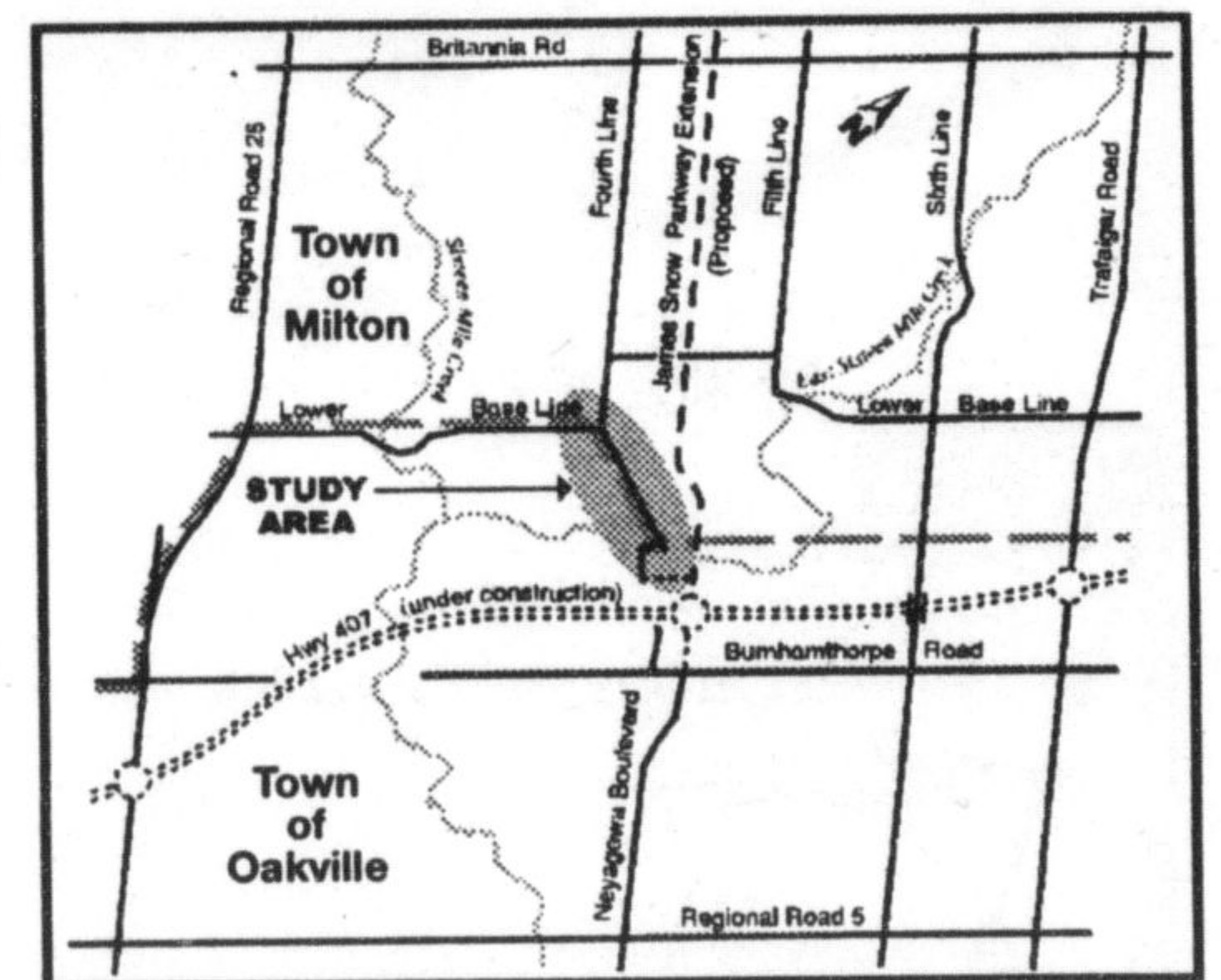
In order to address traffic operational and safety concerns, the Town of Oakville Proposes to permanently close Fourth Line at East Sixteen Mile Creek to vehicular traffic and retain the existing roadway for recreational uses. Following the completion and opening of Highway 407, there is likely to be an increased vehicle demand on the Fourth Line Valley crossing that would have an impact on the safe operation of the road. Within several years, the growth in Fourth Line vehicle demand will be accommodated to the James Snow Parkway Extension to be completed across the valley in accordance with the Environmental Assessment Report, approved in 1999. In the interim period before that roadway is completed, the safe operation of Fourth Line through the Glenorchy area is a concern. The study area is shown on the key plan below.

The study is being carried out as a Class Environmental Assessment following the requirements of the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act, R.S.O. 1997. A public information centre was held on March 6, 2001 to review the alternative improvements for consideration, analysis and evaluation of the alternatives and the technically preferred alternative. Subject to comments received as a result of this notice, and the receipt of necessary approvals, the town intends to permanently close Fourth Line in 2001.

If concerns arise regarding this project, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the Town of Oakville, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environment assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below within 37 calendar days of this Notice. (the required 30-day review period has been extended to accommodate vacations during the summer season). A copy of the request must also be sent to the Town's Director of Public Works. If there is no request received by July 20, 2001, the Town of Oakville will proceed to permanently close Fourth Line at East Sixteen Mile Creek to vehicular traffic.
