A MARRIAGE THAT LASTS!

Today we live in a society where marriage has a greater chance of failing than succeeding. So why is that? There are a number of reasons from, marrying for the wrong reasons, or a couple just "grow apart". I do not want to focus on why marriages break up, but simply on how to keep them together. According to the Bible, we see that both the husband and the wife are commanded to love their spouse. Specifically we see that the husband is supposed to love his wife like Christ loved the church and gave himself for it.

(Ephesians 5:25 KJV) Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

(Titus 2:4 KJV) That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

What we are talking about is a sacrificial love that thinks of the spouse and not just yourself. That is against our nature, but that is

what we need to do in order to keep marriages together and growing.

The Lord loved the church in three areas. He gave of himself and met our spiritual, emotional, and physical needs. It is through Christ that our spirit is saved and will spend eternity with him in heaven. Emotional needs deals with our soul and he gives us the grace and peace through his word daily to succeed in life. Physically the Lord sees to it that we have food, shelter, clothing, and other necessities of life. In other words, the love of Christ goes far beyond feelings and emotions. It is a love that has action. If a marriage is going to last, then the husband and wife must love each other completely. God created us spirit, soul and body. All three of those areas need to be cared for. Any marriage that breaks down can be traced to a break down in one or more of these areas. Usually we think of trying to satisfy physical

needs, and we forget about the spirit and the soul (emotions). The Apostle Paul prayed for a church that he ministered to that the Lord would preserve them blameless in all three areas:

(1 Thessalonians 5:23 KJV) And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

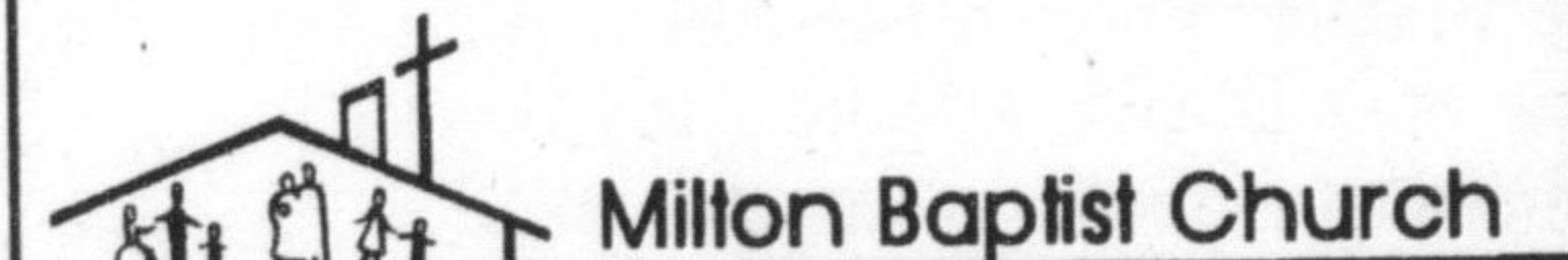

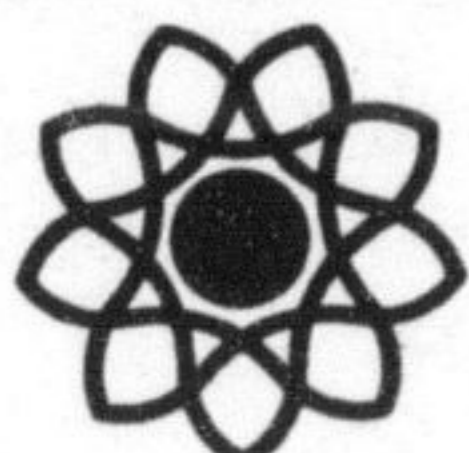
