APPOINTMENT FOR CONTINUATION OF HEARING
The Ontario Municipal board hereby appoints **TUESDAY, the 10th day of JULY, 2001**, at the hour of **10:00 O'CLOCK** (Local Time) in the **forenoon**, at the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 43 BROWN STREET, MILTON, ONTARIO** for the commencement of the hearing of this appeal. The Board has set aside two (2) days for this continuation of hearing on the proposed amending by-law.

Hearing dates are firm - adjournments will not be granted except in the most serious circumstances, and only in accordance with the Board's Rules on Adjournments.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Ontario Municipal Board will reconvene the hearing for the purpose of considering amendments proposed by the Application to the Zoning By-Law Amendment approved by the Board in its Decision of November 28th, 2000.

The proposed amendments, as set out in the draft by-law attached to this Explanatory Note, are as follows:

1. An increase in the total number of permitted units from 189 to 206; and
 2. A requirement that the Applicant relocate the existing Milton tennis Club from the subject property to a new location satisfactory to the Town of Milton.
- In addition to these amendments, the Applicant will be seeking further amendments, as follows:
1. To delete the minimum lot depth requirement of 30 metres;
 2. To increase the maximum building height from 4.5 metres to 5.5 metres; and
 3. To increase the maximum gross floor area for a residential use from 125 square metres to 135 square metres.
