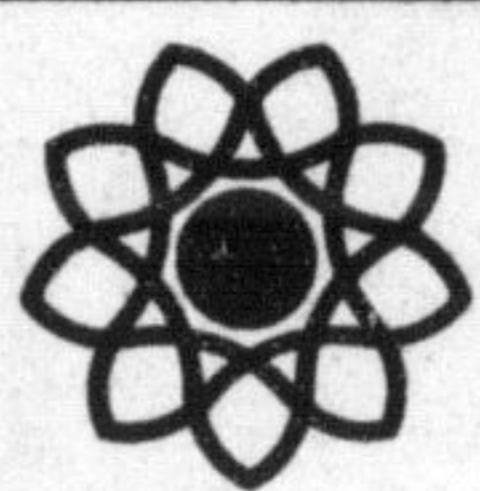
to be in need and what could be done to prevent poverty.

born as a blessing and an opportunity, not a burden on the public purse.
