SOMETHINGS SHOULD NOT BE THROWN AWAY

So many modern products pride themselves in being disposable - diapers, cameras, razors, pens, paper plates and contact lenses - to name a few. Some contemporary thinkers hold that everything ought to be disposable.

However, there are some things that were meant to last forever.

Often, I'm tempted to ask couples about to be wed, "Do you really know what you are getting into?"

Marriage vows warn of tough sledding ahead, "For better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health..."

Dave Morris, personal friend and parishioner, sent me the following anecdote:

A software engineer wrote:

Subject: Failed Upgrade

Last year, I upgraded from Girlfriend 7.0 to Wife 1.0 and noticed that the new program soon began unexpected child processing that took up a lot of space and valuable resources. No mention of this phenomenon was included in the product brochure.

In addition, Wife 1.0 installs itself into all other programs and launches during system initialization, where it monitors

all other system activity. Applications such as Smoking 10.3, Boozing 2.5 and Saturday Night Pubs 5.0 no longer run, crashing the system whenever selected.

I cannot keep Wife 1.0 in the background while attempting to run some of my favourite applications like Night Club 4.3, Dance 'n' Drink 2.0 and Bachelor Party 7.77.

I am thinking about going back to Girlfriend 7.0, but the uninstall does not work on this program. Once I tried to uninstall Wife 1.0 but got this error "General Protection Fault in module House Security. The Uninstall Procedure will abort."

Can you help me please?

Here was the reply from Tech Support:

Re: Failed Upgrade

This is a very common problem among men, but it is done mostly to a primary misconception. Many people upgrade from Girlfriend 7.0 to Wife 1.0 with the idea that Wife 1.0 is merely a UTILITIES & ENTERTAINMENT program. Wife 1.0 is actually an OPERATING SYSTEM and designed by its Creator to run every-

thing.

It is unlikely you would be able to purge Wife 1.0 and still convert back to Girlfriend 7.0. It is impossible to uninstall, delete or purge Wife 1.0 from your system once installed. You cannot go back to Girlfriend 7.0 because Wife 1.0 is not designed to do this. Some have tried to install Girlfriend 8.0 or Wife 2.0 but end up with more problems than the original system (see manual under "Warnings - Alimony/Child Support").

I recommend you keep Wife 1.0 and just deal with the situation. Having Wife 1.0 installed myself, I might also suggest you read the entire section regarding General Partnership Faults (GPF). The best course of action will be to enter the command C:\APOLOGIZE. In fact, I would suggest you use this command every time Wife 1.0 crashes on your system.

Wife 1.0 is a great program, but very high maintenance. Consider buying additional software to improve the performance of Wife 1.0. I recommend Flowers 2.1, Chocolates 5.0 or Movies 4.5.

Do not, under any circumstances,

install Visual Secretary With Short Skirt 3.3. This is not a supported application for Wife 1.0 and is likely to cause irreversible damage to the operating system. Properly supported, Wife 1.0 should run smoothly and effectively forever!


