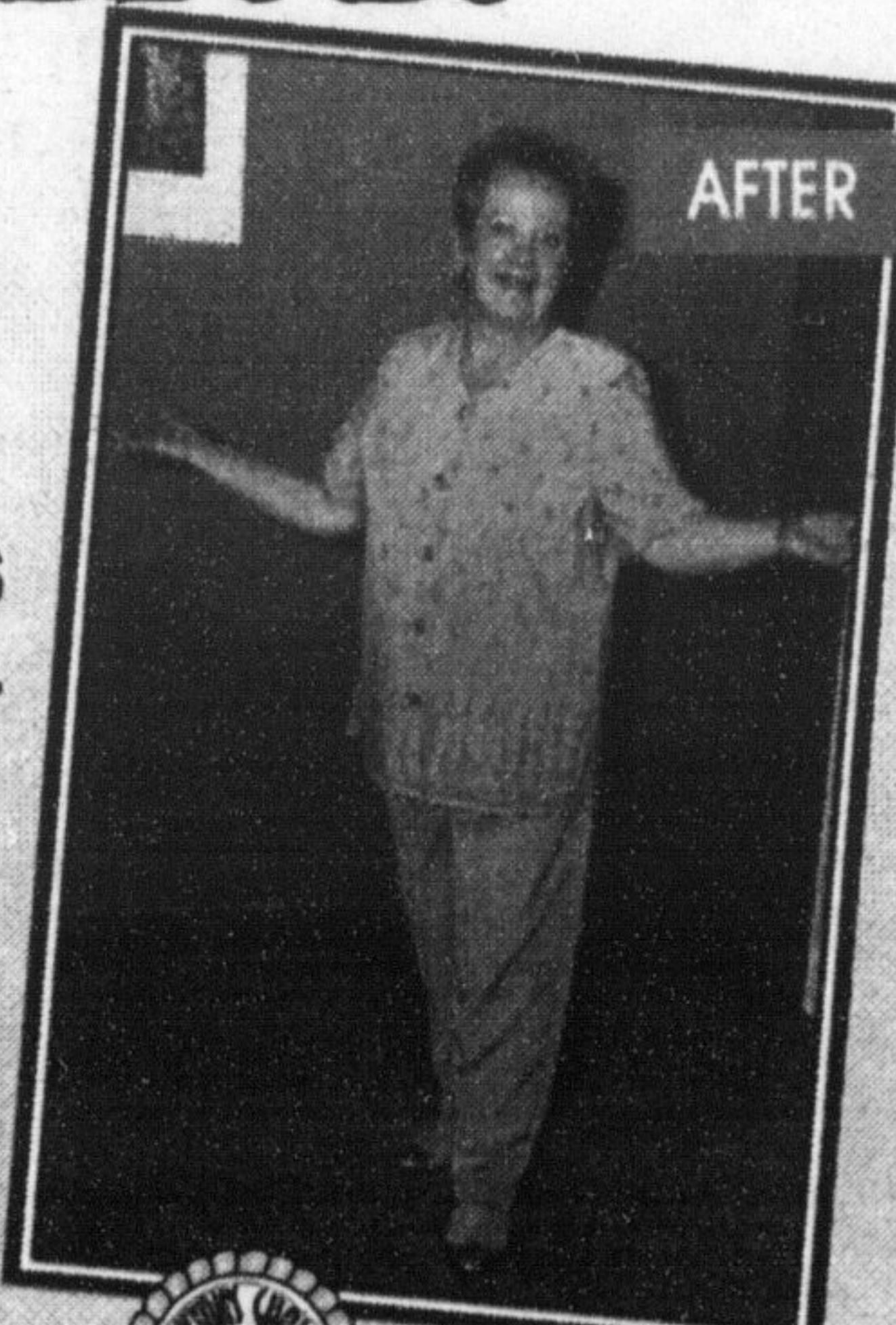

# Milton Tennis Club will find a home in new park

The Milton Tennis Club is moving to a new home.

The club will be relocated from grounds near E.C. Drury High School to the new Community Park, which has yet to be constructed.

The move stems from a controversial development by H.D. Investments, which purchased lands to build a subdivision of geared-for-seniors condominiums on a 33-acre site near the Ontario Street high school.

Town council rejected the proposal, but the Ontario Municipal Board reversed the decision to allow for the development.

Once the project was approved, the question of what would happen to the tennis club became a concern.

The Town's community services and planning departments, as well as its legal counsel finalized the agreement to relocate the club July 10.

The new tennis club, which will include six enclosed tennis courts, a 2,000 square-foot clubhouse and parking, will likely reside at the northern edge of the proposed Community Park.

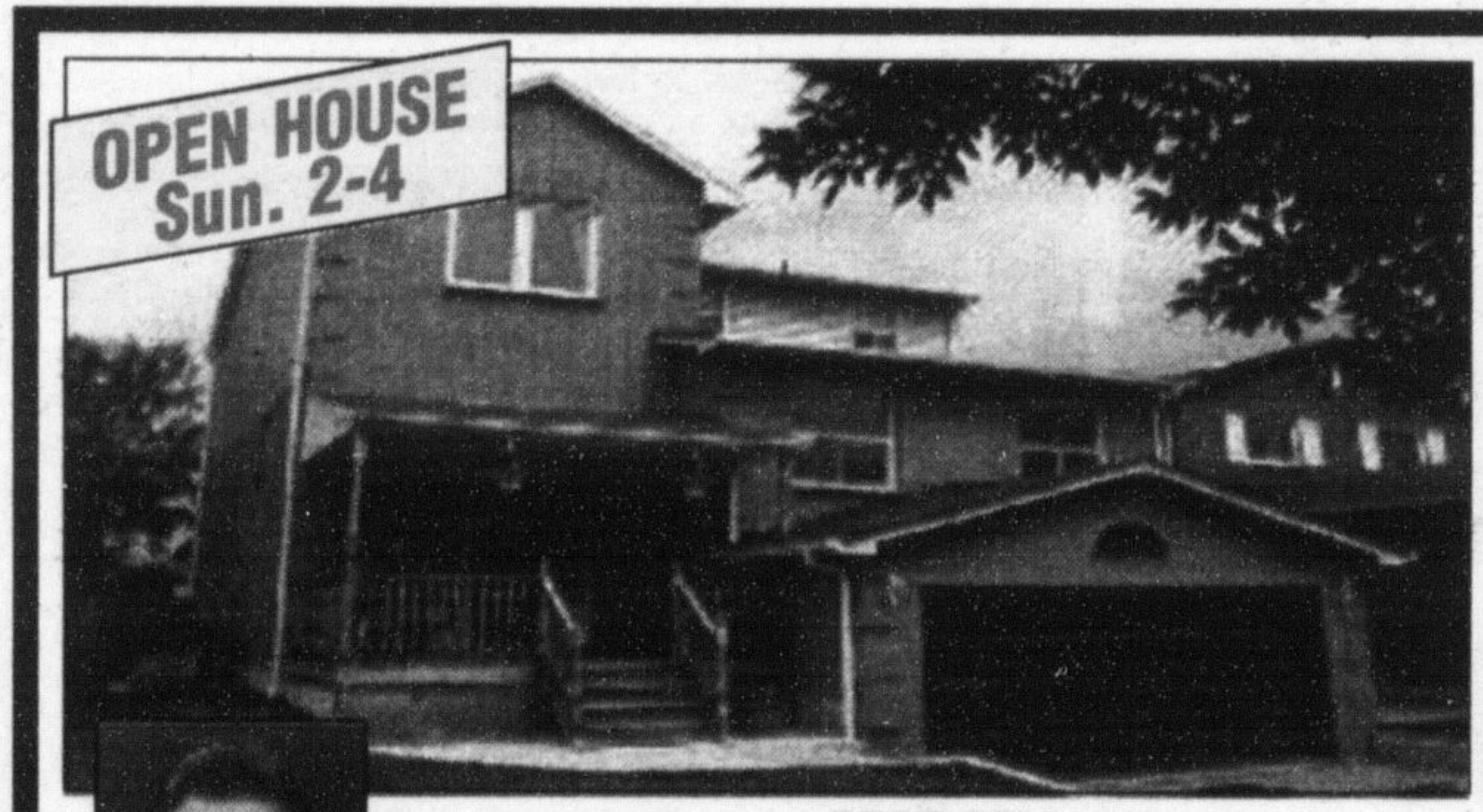
A Community Park master plan will be brought to council for approval later this year.

"The park will be located on the south-west side of Derry Road and Hwy. 25," said Jennifer Reynolds, director of community services. "The earliest the club will be moving is next tennis season (August, 2002)."

The decision to move the club was to make the best of the housing development and allow for the club's expansion, she added.

"We're sorry we have to leave such a nice setting," said tennis club member Derek DeGraw. "But we're looking forward to being part of the new park."

The site will include water, hydro, gas, sanitary sewer and telephone servicing for the future indoor and outdoor 100-acre park and tennis club facilities.
