Red Sox major winning streak has come to end

Call it unlucky 14. It had to end sometime and for the Milton Red Sox a 13-game winning streak was stopped Monday night in a 9-8 loss to Guelph at Maplehurst.

The Red Sox dug themselves an early hole when they trailed 5-0 after the Royals had batted twice. Steve Spiers had early control problems, hitting two batters and throwing some wild pitches. Just as he started to come around, a two-out dribbler through the infield handed Guelph two runs. By the third inning Spiers was humming, but manager Jeff Harper said after the game that he was mostly interested in getting three innings of work for three pitchers in preparation for a big tournament this weekend.

The Red Sox got a couple runs back in the bottom of the second inning when Ryan Harper and Michael Volpe reached base on walks, stole their way around, and then were driven in by an opposite field smash off the bat of Chris Dumencu. They picked up another in the third when Evan Jeans raced home from third on a wild pitch, but then blew a big opportunity when they had the bases loaded with nobody out and couldn't bring in a run.

It almost happened again in the fourth inning. With Spiers and Scott Connolly resting on third and second with nobody out, Guelph brought in a new pitcher who struck out the first two men he faced and then had two strikes on clean-up hitter, Conan O'Brien. O'Brien ripped it into right field, scoring both runners, and then was driven home by Harper to give Milton a 6-5 lead.

Dumencu pitched two scoreless innings in relief and was on his way to a third when the Red Sox blew a rundown play between third and home, allowing a runner to score, and then a Texas Leaguer fell in to score another and give Guelph a 7-6 lead.

The Red Sox alternated in the field between sloppy and competent. They turned a nice double play in the seventh to get out of a bases loaded nobody out situation, and catcher Jeans made a spectacular catch of a foul ball as well as throwing out a runner trying to steal third. Volpe could have held the Royals scoreless over the final three frames if not for errors resulting in unearned runs.

The Red Sox got one back in the seventh after Harper reached base for the fourth consecutive time, and was driven in by Volpe. O'Brien smashed a double to bring home Jeans for Milton's other

The Red Sox got runners to second and third in the ninth inning but couldn't get them home. The big blow was Paul Duff being called out on a questionable third-strike appeal call.

Jeff Harper wasn't too upset about the loss or that the winning streak had been stopped. You don't win 13 games in a row without being good, as well as having a little luck. "Eventually, the breaks are going to go against you. Guelph is the best team we've played in a month. They're probably the best hitting team in the

Harper suggested it wasn't a must-win game or he might have done some things differently. They were preparing for an important AAA tournament this weekend in St. Catharines.

Milton has a 21-6 overall record and is 15-4 in league games.
