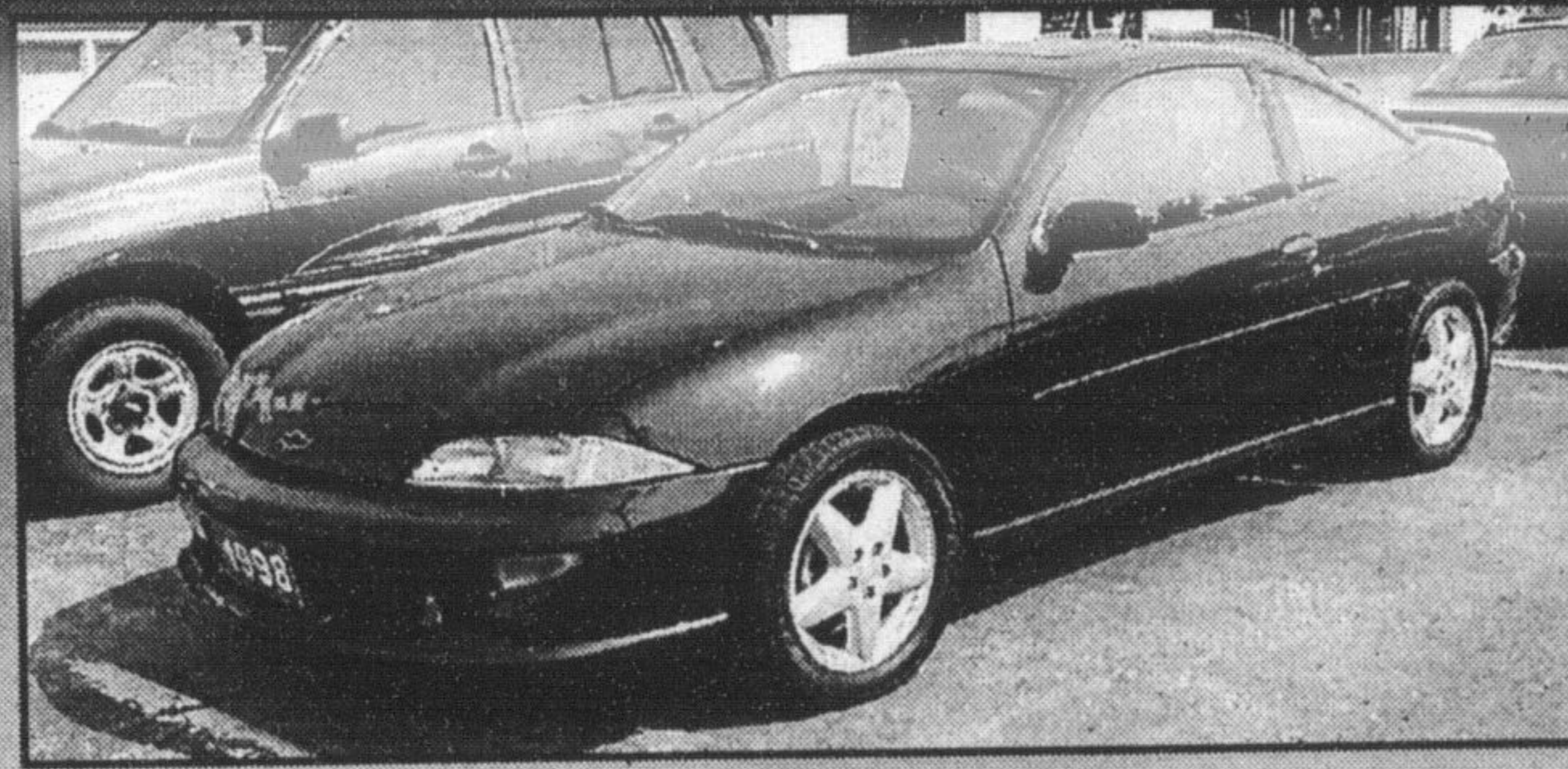

Police encountering minimal problems with bush parties

For the first time in recent memory, the typical bush parties that occur in town at this time of year have been hush-hush.

"It's been extremely quiet," said Const. Rick Earle, district crime analyst for Halton Regional Police. "We don't appear to be experiencing any problems this year."

The parties are popular at the end of the school year or when the weather is warm, he said.

"(Bush parties) are a phenomenon that never went away. They're

held in rural areas where there's enough room for cars to park. The spots are usually not too far from the road but far enough to conceal yourself."

Phone calls of complaints will prompt the officers to check out the scene.

"The odd time we'll send the police dogs along. We usually go (to the scene of the parties) if we hear about them. Sometimes officers will be riding by and see a bunch of cars on the side of the road and decide to investigate. But we don't patrol certain areas more

than others."

If there's indeed a bush party taking place, up to three officers will go in and break up the gathering, Const. Earle said.

"Usually the kids run. Alcohol is almost always involved. The officers will confiscate the alcohol. Usually bush parties aren't violent in nature toward police."

Const. Earle warned excessive drinking is common at bush parties and some younger teenagers might not be used to heavy drinking.

"They might become ill or disoriented."

NOTICE: UNCLAIMED DAMAGE DEPOSITS

The following is a list of unclaimed monies for damage deposits that were collected for work on private property affecting Town of Milton road allowances and other properties. According to Town By-law 31-94, all monies remaining unclaimed for a period of six years from the date of deposit, may be transferred to the general funds of the Town, provided that a notice containing a list of such unclaimed monies, including the names of the depositor is published.

This notice is to inform all persons having any claim to any of such monies are required to prove their claims within ninety days from the publication of this notice. Upon the expiration of ninety days from the publication of this notice, the Town Treasurer may transfer all of such monies against which no claim has been made to the general funds of the Town, free of and from any and all claims of any kind whatsoever. Where monies are claimed as a result of said notice being published, an administration fee of 10% of the amount of each deposit plus G.S.T. shall be deducted before any monies are refunded.
